Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities Week 1 of September 2020

Date of Release: 18-SEPTEMBER 2020

1. Prices of a kilogram of rice went down by PhP 1.00 in Batangas City and Butuan City, and by PhP 2.00 in the National Capital Region and Iloilo City during the week. Meanwhile, it picked up by PhP 1.00 per kilogram in Legazpi City. (Table 1)
2. A kilogram of beef and pork declined by PhP 10.00 to PhP 30.00 in Cabanatuan City and Batangas City during the week. On the other hand, the price of beef with bones rose by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Davao City. (Table 2)
3. Price changes by PhP 10.00 and PhP 20.00 per kilogram of galunggong were reported in four regional centers during the week. (Table 3)
4. Varied price movements in vegetables were observed in many regional centers this week. (Table 4)
5. Price hikes, ranging from PhP 10.00 to PhP 40.00 per kilogram of red onion, were seen in six regional centers this week. However, it was cheaper by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Cabanatuan City. (Table 5)
6. Five regional centers registered price changes of banana, ranging from PhP 2.00 to PhP 10.00 per kilogram, during the period. (Table 6)
7. Prices for a kilogram of refined sugar and a long neck bottle of cooking oil were lower by PhP 1.00 and PhP 2.00, respectively, in Batangas City during the week. (Table 7)
