Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 2 of June 2020

Date of Release: 30 June 2020

1. Price changes ranging from PhP 0.25 to PhP 3.00 per kilogram of rice were observed in four regional centers during the week. (Table 1)
2. Prices of beef and pork went up by PhP 10.00 to PhP 30.00 per kilogram in six regional centers during the period. However, it decreased by PhP 10.00 in San Fernando City (Region 1). (Table 2)
3. A kilogram of galunggong was priced lower by PhP 20.00 to PhP 40.00 in four regional centers during the week. Meanwhile, it was higher by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Iloilo City and Zamboanga City, and by PhP 20.00 per kilogram in Legazpi City and Davao City. (Table 3)
4. Price decreases in vegetables are observed in many regional centers during the week. (Table 4)
5. Prices of a kilogram of hawaiian ginger dropped by PhP 20.00 in four regional centers and by PhP 30.00 in Cebu City during the period. However, it picked up by PhP 20.00 per kilogram in Legazpi City. (Table 5)
6. A kilogram of calamansi dropped by PhP 10.00 in Baguio City and Zamboanga City, and by PhP 20.00 in Legazpi City. On the other hand, it rose by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Tuguegarao City and Davao City. (Table 6)
7. Prices of brown and refined sugar in Batangas City picked up by PhP 1.00 and PhP 4.00 per kilogram, respectively. Likewise, refined sugar was higher by PhP 1.00 per kilogram in Cebu City. (Table 7)
