Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 4 of June 2020

Date of Release: 24 July 2020

1. Price declines, ranging from PhP 0.40 to PhP 1.00 per kilogram of well milled and regular milled rice, were observed in four regional centers during the week. (Table 1)
2. Four regional centers posted price increases in pork by PhP 10.00 to PhP 30.00 per kilogram this week. (Table 2)
3. Price changes by PhP 10.00 and PhP 20.00 per kilogram of galunggong were registered in seven regional centers during the period. (Table 3)
4. Mixed price movements in vegetables were noted among the regional centers during the week. (Table 4)
5. This week's prices of a kilogram of imported garlic dropped by PhP 10.00 to PhP 50.00 in five regional centers. However, it went up by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in the National Capital Region (NCR). (Table 5)
6. Price mark-ups, ranging from PhP 5.00 to PhP 40.00 per kilogram of carabao mango, were posted in six regional centers. Meanwhile, it was priced lower by PhP 20.00 per kilogram in Davao City. (Table 6)
7. Prices of other basic commodities remained stable during the week. (Table 7)
