Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities Week 4 of December 2020

Date of Release: 13 January 2021

1. A kilogram of dressed chicken was sold higher by PhP 1.67 to PhP 8.00 in nine regional centers during the week. Meanwhile, its average retail price per kilogram dropped by PhP 0.67 in San Fernando City (Region 1). (Table 1)
2. The average retail price per kilogram of galunggong picked up by PhP 6.93 to PhP 29.00 in seven regional centers during the period. On the contrary, its average retail price per kilogram was lower by PhP 4.00 in Legazpi City. (Table 2)
3. Varied price movements in vegetables were noted in many regional centers during the week. (Table 3)
4. Price declines, ranging from PhP 2.00 to PhP 70.00, per kilogram of red onion were registered in 10 regional centers during the period. On the other hand, its average retail price per kilogram was higher by PhP 3.03 in the National Capital Region (NCR) and by PhP 6.00 in Cebu City. (Table 4)
5. The average retail prices of calamansi increased by PhP 2.00 to PhP 14.98 per kilogram in nine regional centers during the week. Its average retail price per kilogram, however, decreased by PhP 10.00 in Calapan City. (Table 5)
6. Prices of other basic commodities generally retained their previous week's levels. (Table 6)
