Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 2 of August 2020

Date of Release: 26 August 2020

1. An increase of PhP 1.00 per kilogram in the price of well milled rice was observed in Butuan City during the week. Meanwhile, the price per kilogram of regular milled rice dropped by PhP 0.50 in the National Capital Region (NCR) and by PhP 1.00 in Batangas City. (Table 1)
2. A kilogram of beef was priced higher by PhP 10.00 in Batangas City and by PhP 30.00 in Cabanatuan City during the week. On the other hand, its prevailing price per kilogram was lower by PhP 5.00 in NCR and by PhP 10.00 in Cebu City. (Table 2)
3. Price mark-ups, ranging from PhP 10.00 to PhP 50.00, per kilogram of galunggong were noted in five regional centers during the week. However, it fell by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Naga City. (Table 3)
4. Price movements in vegetables were varied in selected regional centers this week. (Table 4)
5. Price increments in red onion during the week ranged from PhP 5.00 to PhP 20.00 per kilogram in four regional centers. On the contrary, it went down by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Naga City. (Table 5)
6. A PhP 10.00 per kilogram price hike in carabao mango was registered in NCR and Butuan City during the period. (Table 6)
7. Prices of other basic commodities remained stable during the week. (Table 7)
