Price Situationer of Selected Agricultural Commodities

Week 2 of July 2020

Date of Release: 20 August 2020

1. Prices of a kilogram of well milled and regular milled rice in Davao City correspondingly decreased by PhP 1.00 and PhP 2.00 during the week. (Table 1)
2. Price cuts by PhP 10.00 and PhP 20.00 per kilogram of beef and pork were observed in Cabanatuan City during the period. (Table 2)
3. A kilogram of galunggong dropped by PhP 20.00 in Baguio City and Butuan City, and by PhP 40.00 in San Fernando City. However, its price per kilogram increased by PhP 10.00 in Legazpi City, and by PhP 20.00 in the National Capital Region (NCR) and Naga City. (Table 3)
4. Prices of vegetables generally declined in many regional centers this week. (Table 4)
5. A kilogram of hawaiian ginger was priced lower by PhP 5.00 to PhP 20.00 in six regional centers. Meanwhile, it climbed by PhP 40.00 per kilogram in Cebu City. (Table 5)
6. A PhP 10.00 per kilogram price decrease in calamansi was seen in four regional centers. On the contrary, it was priced higher by PhP 10.00 per kilogram in Zamboanga City. (Table 6)
7. Prices of sugar and cooking oil remained stable during the week, except in NCR where price of refined sugar rose by PhP 1.00 per kilogram. (Table 7)
