

## CONSTRUCTION SECTOR (Total Employment of 20 and Over)

### Number of Establishments

About 629 construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over were covered in 2008.

- General engineering construction accounted for 344 establishments (54.7%).
- Building installation comprised of 133 establishments (21.1 %).
- Non-residential building construction with 72 establishments (11.4 %).

(Figure 1 shows the distribution of construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over by industry group and sub-class.)

### Employment

Construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over reported an estimated of 122,393 workers in 2008. The most number of workers were employed in the following industries:

- General Engineering construction with 68,902 workers (56.3%).
- Non-residential building construction with 26,337 workers (21.5%).
- Building installation with 16,040 workers (13.1 %).

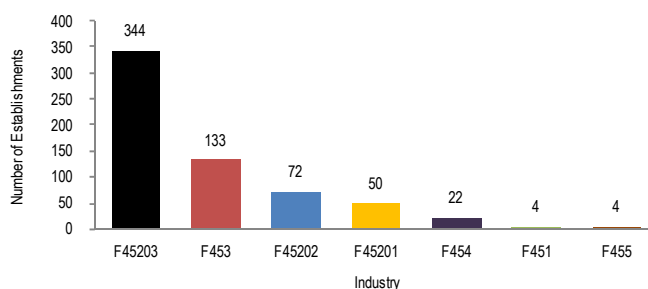


FIGURE 2 Employment for Construction Establishments with Total Employment of 20 and Over by Industry Group and Sub-Class: Philippines, 2008

(Figure 2 displays the distribution of employment for construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over by industry group and sub-class.)

### Value of Output

Value of output generated in 2008 by construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over was estimated at PhP171.2 billion. The industries that generated the highest output value are as follows:

- General engineering construction with value of output amounting to PhP108.7 billion (63.5%).
- Non-residential building construction with PhP31.6 billion (18.4%).
- Building installation with PhP21.3 billion (12.4%).

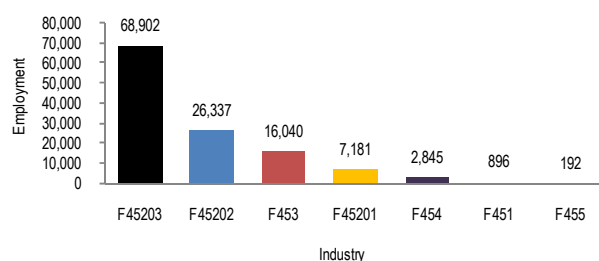


FIGURE 3 Value of Output for Construction Establishments with Total Employment of 20 and Over by Industry Group and Sub-Class: Philippines, 2008

(Figure 3 shows the distribution of value of output for construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over by industry group and sub-class.)

### Gross Addition to Fixed Assets

Gross addition to fixed assets of construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over amounted to PhP4.2 billion. The following industries registered the highest gross addition to fixed assets:

- General engineering construction with Php3.0 billion (69.5%).
- Non-residential building construction with PhP873.4 million (20.5%).
- Building installation with PhP183.0 million (4.3%).

(Figure 3 shows the distribution of gross addition to fixed assets of construction establishments with total employment of 20 and over by industry group and sub-class.)

FIGURE 1 Number of Construction Establishments with Total Employment of 20 and Over by Industry Group and Sub-Class: Philippines, 2008

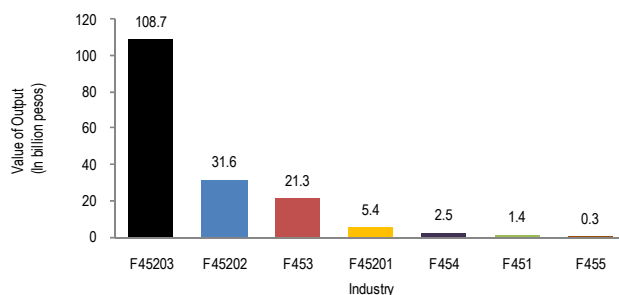
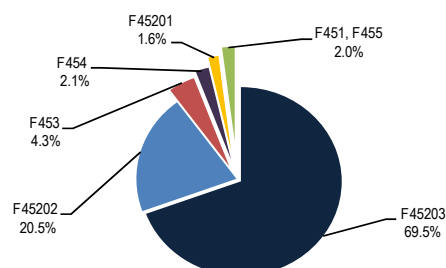


FIGURE 4 Percentage Distribution of Gross Addition to Fixed Assets for Construction Establishments with Total Employment of 20 and Over by Industry Group and Sub-Class: Philippines, 2008
