

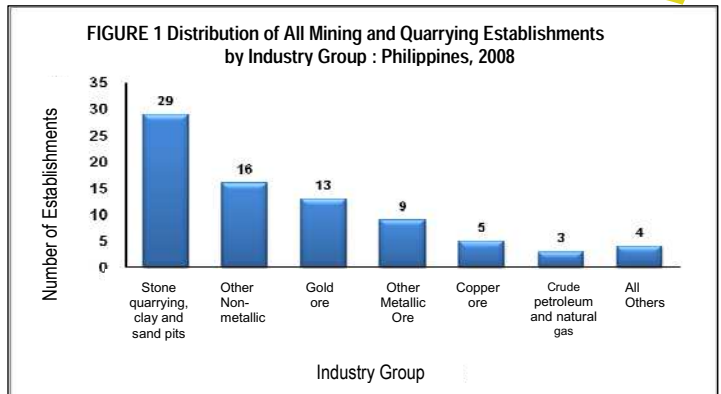
## MINING & QUARRYING SECTOR (All Establishments)

### Number of Establishments

A total of 79 mining and quarrying establishments were covered by the 2008 Annual Survey of Philippine Business Industry. In terms of the number of establishments, the sector was dominated by the following industries:

- Stone quarrying, clay and sandpits with 29 establishments (36.7%)
- Other non-metallic mining, 16 establishments (20.3%)
- Gold ore mining, 13 establishments (16.5%)

(Figure 1 shows the distribution of all mining and quarrying establishments by industry group.)

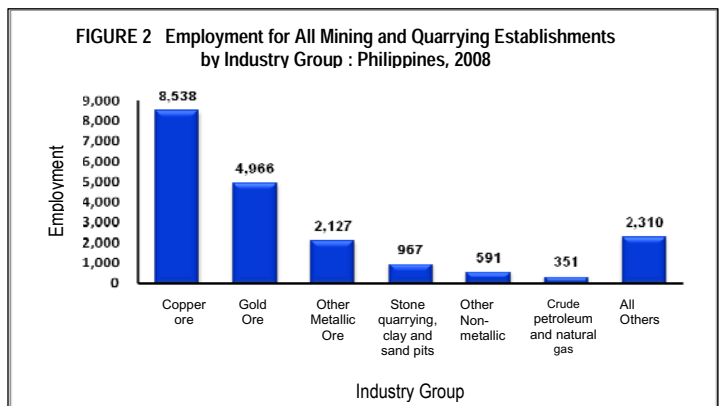


### Employment

Employment in 2008 by all mining and quarrying establishments was estimated at 19,850 workers. The industries that recorded the most number of workers are:

- Copper ore mining with 8,538 workers (43.0%)
- Gold ore mining with 4,966 workers (25.0%)
- Other metallic ore mining with 2,127 workers (10.7%)

(Figure 2 shows the distribution of employment for all mining and quarrying establishments by industry group.)

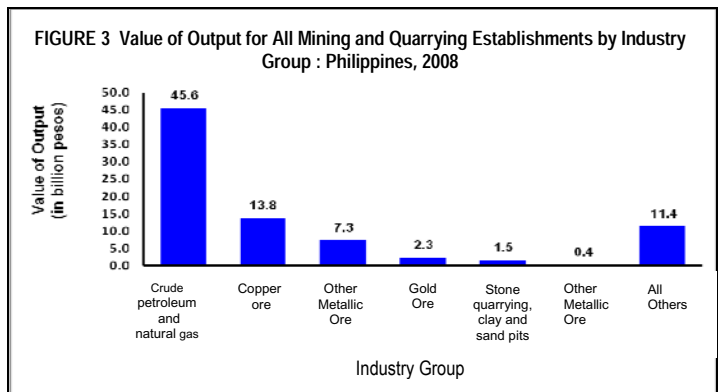


### Value of Output

Value of output generated in 2008 by all mining and quarrying establishments reached PhP81.9 billion. The top three grossers are:

- Extraction and production of crude petroleum and natural gas with output value of PhP45.6 billion (55.7%)
- Copper ore mining, PhP13.8 billion (16.9%)
- Other metallic ore mining, PhP7.3 billion (8.9%)

(Figure 3 shows the distribution of value of output for all mining and quarrying establishments by industry group.)



### Gross Addition to Fixed Assets

Gross addition to fixed assets for all mining and quarrying establishments amounted to PhP17.4 billion in 2008. Among industries, the following reported the highest addition to fixed assets :

- Extraction and production of crude petroleum and natural gas, PhP10.9 billion (62.9%)
- Copper ore mining, PhP3.4 billion (19.6%)
- Other metallic ore mining, PhP1.5 billion (8.7%)

(Figure 4 shows the distribution of gross addition to fixed assets for all mining and quarrying establishments by industry group.)
