

Highlights of the 2000 Census of Population and Housing

BILIRAN

Smallest Province in Eastern Visayas in Terms of Population

The island province of Biliran lies near the north of the coast of Leyte. Carigara Bay to the south and Biliran Strait to the west of the island separate it from Leyte.

The island is mountainous, with peaks rising to a maximum height in the southeast at Mount Suiro. The climate of Biliran is rainy throughout the year with rainfall heaviest during December and January.

When Samar and Leyte were divided in 1768, Biliran became part of Leyte. It remained part of that province until 1959, when it was constituted as a sub-province with the enactment of Republic Act No. 2141. Finally, in May 1992, by virtue of Republic Act No. 7160, the island became a separate province.

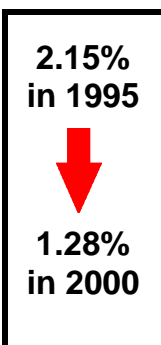
It is the smallest province in Eastern Visayas with an area of about 532 square kilometers. As of 2000, Biliran has a total of 132 barangays.



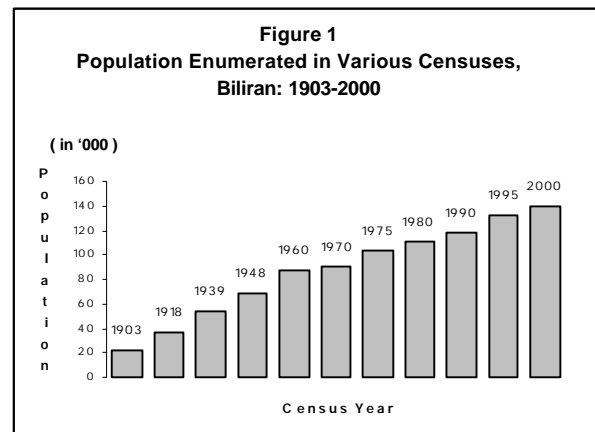
POPULATION CHARACTERISTICS

Population growth rate decreased to 1.28 percent

Biliran registered a total population of 140,274 as of May 1, 2000. This was higher by 8,065 persons when compared to the 1995 figure (with September 1, 1995 as the reference date).



Biliran registered an average annual population growth rate of 1.28 percent during the intercensal period 1995 to 2000, down from 2.15 percent during the 1990 to 1995 period.



Among the eight municipalities in Biliran, Naval, the provincial capital, was the largest in terms of population size, comprising 27.07 percent of the total population. This was followed by the municipalities of Caibira (13.98 percent), Cabucgayan (12.61 percent), and Kawayan (12.48 percent).

Naval was the fastest growing municipality in terms of population growth rate at 3.08 percent. It registered an increase of 1.19 percentage points from the 1.89 percent growth rate during the 1990 to 1995 period. This was followed by the municipalities of Cabucgayan (1.51 percent), Kawayan (1.38 percent), Maripipi (1.24 percent), and Caibira (1.16 percent).

The municipalities of Almeria and Biliran had less than one percent growth rate (0.68 and 0.07 percent, respectively) while the municipality of Culaba had a negative growth rate (-2.10 percent).

Average household size slightly decreased to 5.02 persons

The number of households in Biliran was registered at 27,909 in 2000, or an increase of 2,263 households over the 1995 figure. The average household size of 5.02 persons slightly decreased from 5.15 persons in 1995.



In 2000, the overall dependency ratio was registered at 85



The proportion of young dependents (0 to 14 years old) was 40.53 percent, down from 41.16 percent in 1995. Old dependents (65 years old and above), on the other hand, made up 5.44 percent of the total population of Biliran, higher by 0.52 percentage point from 4.92 percent in 1995. The population in the working age group (15 to 64 years old) which comprised 54.03 percent of the total population was slightly higher than that of the 1995 figure (53.92 percent).

In 2000, dependency ratio was 85, the same as the 1995 figure. This means that, for every 100 persons in the working age group, there were 85 dependents, that is, 75 young dependents and 10 old dependents. Biliran had a median age of 20 years in 2000, slightly higher than the median age of 19 years in 1990 and 1995.

Males outnumbered females with a sex ratio of 103 males for every 100 females. Males dominated the age group 49 years and below while females in the age group 50 years and above.

In 2000, the sex ratio was 103

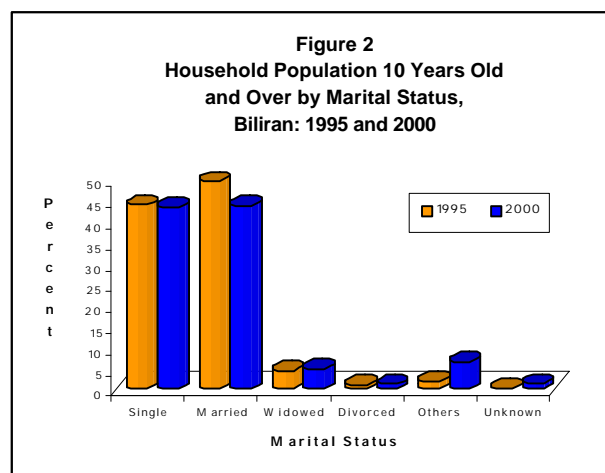


In 2000, the age group 5 to 9 years had the largest population with 14.19 percent, followed by the age group 10 to 14 years with 13.12 percent.



More single men than women

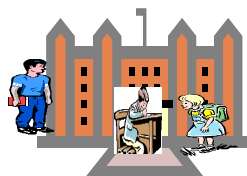
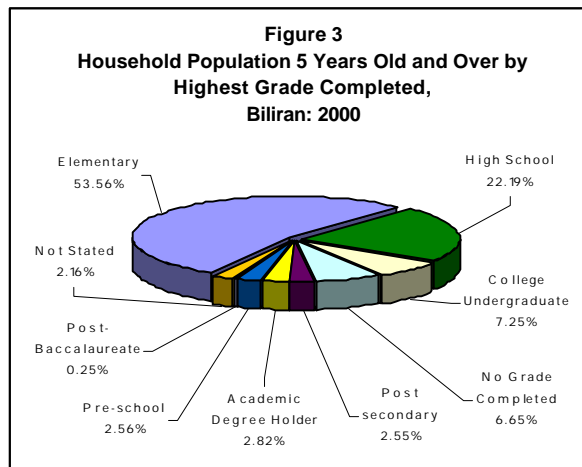
About 43.57 percent of those aged 10 years and over were married, lower by 5.85 percentage points from that of the 1995 figure (49.42 percent). Following closely were those who were single persons, comprising 43.25 percent. This was slightly lower than the 1995 figure of 43.58 percent. The widowed, divorced/separated and those in common-law/live-in arrangements made up 12.02 percent.



More than half (54.51 percent) of the single population were males. On the other hand, females dominated the married (50.29 percent), widowed (75.49 percent), and divorced/separated populace (59.77 percent).

More females in higher levels of education

Of the household population five years old and over, 53.56 percent attended or completed elementary education. This was lower by 0.74 percentage point from that of the 1995 figure (54.30 percent). About 22.19 percent reached or completed secondary education; 7.25 percent, college; 2.82 percent were academic degree holders; and 0.25 percent with post baccalaureate courses.



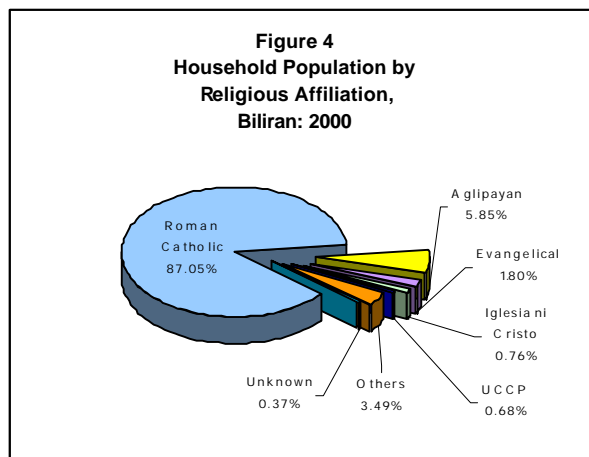
Those who had no grade/year completed made up 6.65 percent, of which more than half (53.56 percent) were males.

There were more males than females among those who attended or finished elementary (52.49 percent vs. 47.51 percent) and post secondary education (57.88 percent vs. 42.12 percent). On the other hand, there were more females than males among those who attended college (52.11 percent vs. 47.89 percent), were academic degree holders (62.93 percent vs. 37.07 percent), and with post baccalaureate courses (61.46 percent vs. 38.54 percent).

Almost nine out of ten were Roman Catholics



Almost nine out of ten of the household population of Biliran were Roman Catholics. This was followed by Aglipayans and Evangelicals with 5.85 percent and 1.80 percent, respectively. On the other hand, Iglesia ni Cristo and United Church of Christ in the Philippines members shared less than one percent each. Other religious affiliations included Protestant (0.30 percent), Jehovah's Witness (0.28 percent), Islam (0.05 percent), and Buddhist (0.03 percent).

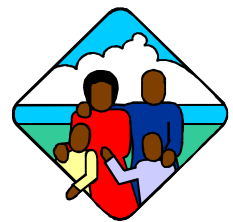


Majority of the population remained in the same municipality

Of the 121,641 household population aged five years and over, 94.89 percent had been in the same municipality five years ago. About 0.23 percent moved in from other municipalities of Biliran, 1.94 percent from other provinces, and 0.13 percent from other countries.

Two out of five of the household population classified themselves as Waray

Two out of five (40.62 percent) of the household population in Biliran classified themselves as Waray. Other ethnic groups included Binisaya/Bisaya (30.79 percent), Cebuano (26.20 percent), Tagalog (0.25 percent), and Kankanai/Kankaney/Kankanaey (0.15 percent).

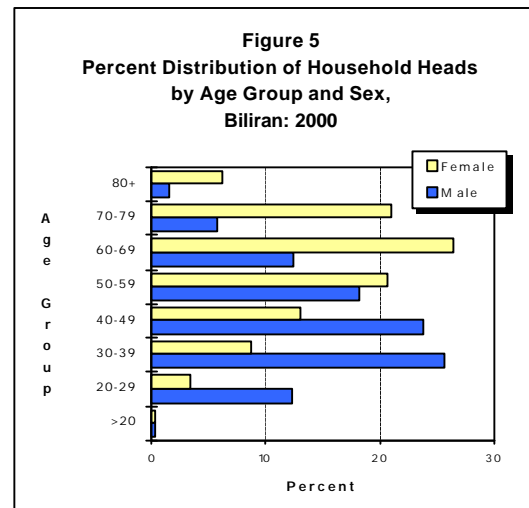


More male-headed households in Biliran

Majority (86.33 percent) of the households in Biliran were headed by males.



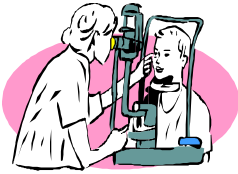
Among males, headship rate peaked at ages 30 to 39 years (25.57 percent) while headship rate for females was highest at the age group 60 to 69 years (26.49 percent).



Majority of the household population were Filipinos

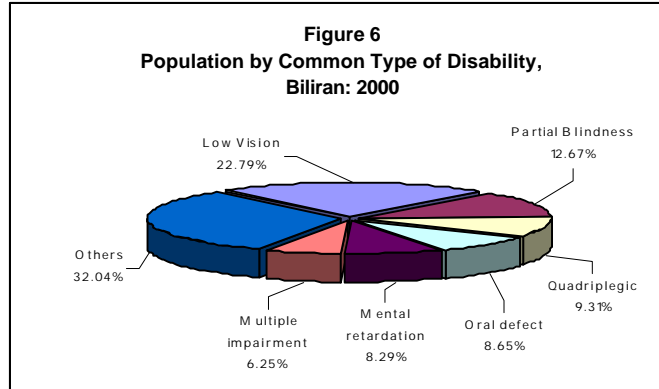
Of the 140,174 household population in Biliran, 93.70 percent were Filipinos. This was lower by 6.28 percentage points from the 1990 figure. The province's household population also consisted of 0.37 percent British, 0.31 percent Chinese, and 0.09 percent Americans.

Number of individuals with disability in Biliran increased by 327 persons



About 1,966 persons, or 1.40 percent of the total population had disabilities. Among them, there were more males (53.05 percent) than females (46.95 percent).

The most frequently reported type of disability in Census 2000 was low vision with 22.79 percent. It was followed by partial blindness (12.67 percent), quadriplegic (9.31 percent), oral defect (8.65 percent), mental retardation (8.29 percent), and multiple impairment (6.25 percent).



Majority were studying in the same municipality of residence

Of the 43,019 household population five years old and over who attended school from March 1999 to June 2000, majority (92.35 percent) were studying in the same municipality where they resided. Those studying in another municipality of Biliran comprised 1.74 percent; 2.64 percent in other provinces; and 0.05 percent in foreign countries.



There were more males (50.87 percent) among those studying in the same municipality where they resided. On the other hand, there were more females among those studying in the municipality outside of their residence but within Biliran, other provinces, and foreign countries.

Nine out of ten were literate in Biliran

Nine out of ten (90.80 percent) of the household population were literate, slightly higher by 0.34 percentage point than the 1990 Census (90.46 percent). There were more literate females (91.25 percent) than males (90.36 percent).

Literacy rate among the 20 to 24 year age group was the highest at 96.14 percent.

Forty six percent of ever-married women had one to three children

Of the 19,221 ever-married women 15 to 49 years old in Biliran, 40.64 percent had four or more children while 45.94 percent had one to three children. The average number of children ever-born to an ever-married woman was three. The proportion of ever-married women who were childless was 12.05 percent.

Average age at first marriage was 21 years

Ever-married women in Biliran recorded an average age at first marriage of 21 years.



About 16 percent of ever-married women (15 to 49 years old) got married before they reached the legal age of marriage (18 years). On the other hand, 70 percent got married at the age of 18 to 29 years and 3.21 percent at the age of 30 years and above.

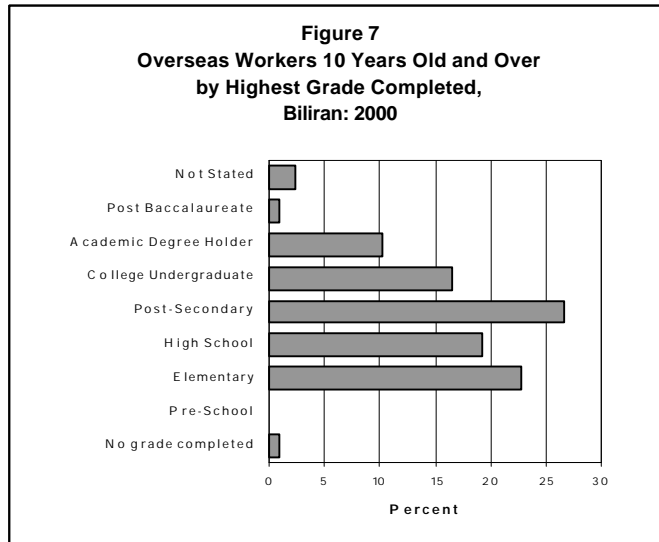
More male overseas workers than females

The number of overseas workers in this province in 2000 was 1,217 persons. This registered an increase of 478 persons from the number reported in 1995 (739 persons). More than half (65.65 percent) of them were males.



The largest proportion of overseas workers were 45 years old and above (18.57 percent). This was followed by the age groups 35 to 39 years (15.53 percent) and 30 to 34 years (15.12 percent).

One fourth of these overseas workers (26.62 percent) reached or attended post secondary education; 22.76 percent, elementary education; 19.23 percent, high school; 10.27 percent were academic degree holders; and 0.99 percent with post baccalaureate courses.



Almost nine out of ten (89.51 percent) of the male overseas workers reached or attended post secondary education. On the other hand, the largest proportion of female overseas workers (46.57 percent) reached or attended elementary education.

HOUSEHOLD CHARACTERISTICS

Almost two out of five households used Waray as the language or dialect

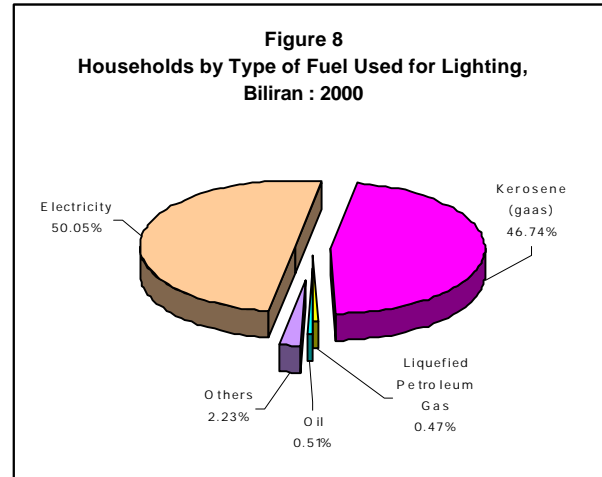
About 37.67 percent of households were using Waray as the language or dialect. This was followed by Cebuano (36.73 percent) and Binisaya/Bisaya (24.73 percent). Less than one percent used other languages or dialects.

More than half of the households used electricity for lighting

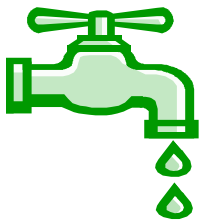


In 2000, half (50.05 percent) of the households used electricity for lighting, higher by 23.53 percentage points from the 1990 Census results (26.52 percent).

On the other hand, the proportion of households using kerosene (gaas) as lighting declined from 69.07 percent in 1990 to 46.74 percent in 2000.

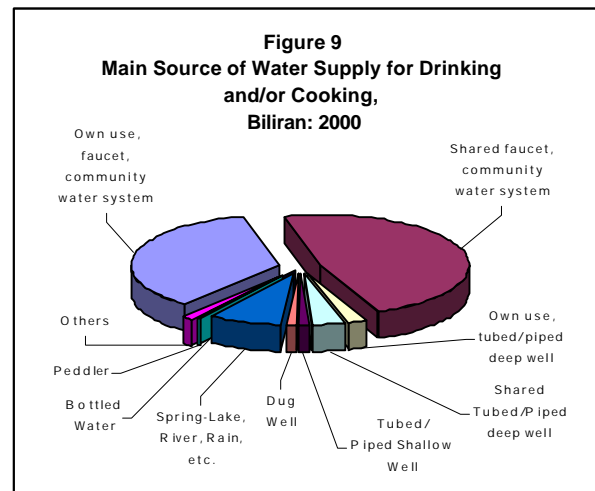


Almost half of the households shared the faucet connected to a community water system as the main source of water supply for drinking and/or cooking



Almost half (47.59 percent) of the households shared the faucet connected to a community water system as the main source of water supply for drinking and/or cooking. This figure registered an increase of 4.14 percentage points from the 1990 figure of 43.45 percent.

The proportion of households which had their own faucet connected to a community water system was 34.92 percent.



Shared faucet connected to a community water system was the main source of water supply for laundry and/or bathing in Biliran

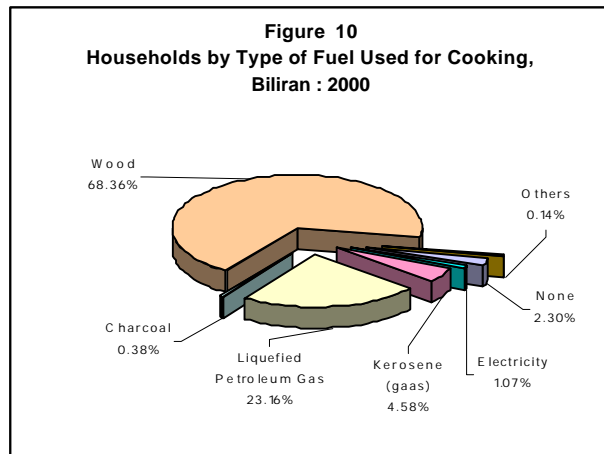
Two out of five households shared the faucet connected to a community water system as the main source of water supply for laundry and/or bathing. This was followed by households which had their own faucet connected to a community water system (35.58 percent); and spring, lake, river, rain, etc. (11.42 percent).



Two out of three households used wood as fuel for cooking



About 68.36 percent of households were using wood as fuel for cooking, lower than the 1990 figure (89.75 percent). On the other hand, those households using Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) increased from 3.35 percent in 1990 to 23.16 percent in 2000.



Water-sealed sewer/septic tank used exclusively by the household increased by 18.73 percentage points

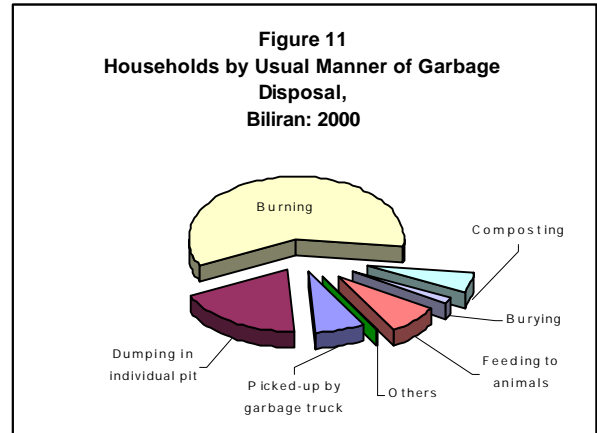


Toilet facility is an indicator of health and sanitation status of the households. Nearly half (48.79 percent) of the households exclusively used water-sealed sewer/septic tank as their toilet facility. This figure was higher than the 1990 figure (30.06 percent). This was followed by water-sealed other depository used exclusively by the households, 10.18 percent; water-sealed sewer/septic tank shared with other households, 6.10 percent; open pit, 5.54 percent; and closed pit, 3.49 percent. Other types of toilet facility (pail system etc.) and water-sealed other depository and shared with other households registered below two percent each. On the other hand, 22.11 percent reported no toilet facility at all.

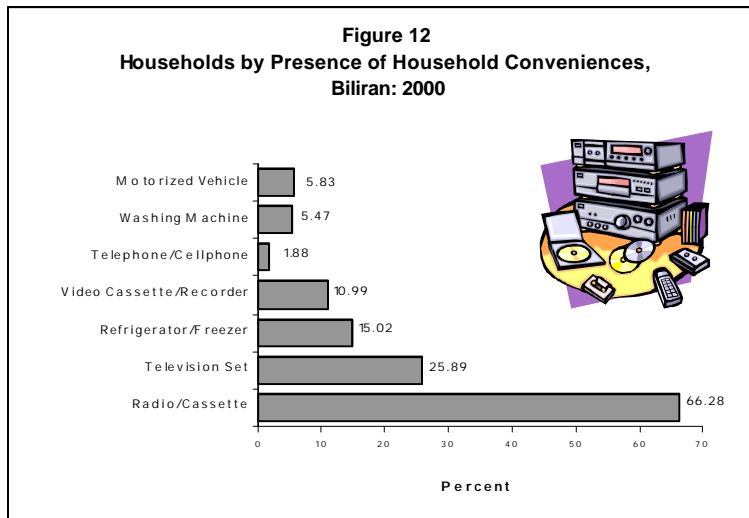
Burning was the usual manner of garbage disposal in Biliran



In 2000, 59.11 percent of the households disposed their garbage through burning. This was lower than the 1990 result (63.07 percent). Other manner of garbage disposal included dumping in individual pit but not burned (18.72 percent), being picked up by a garbage truck (7.33 percent), and composting and later used as fertilizer (5.10 percent).



More than three out of five of the households had radio/cassette



Of the 27,909 households, 66.28 percent had radio/cassette. This was followed by television set (25.89 percent), refrigerator/freezer (15.02 percent), and video cassette/recorder (10.99 percent). The least reported household convenience was the telephone/cellphone (1.88 percent).

Almost one out of five of the households owned an agricultural land

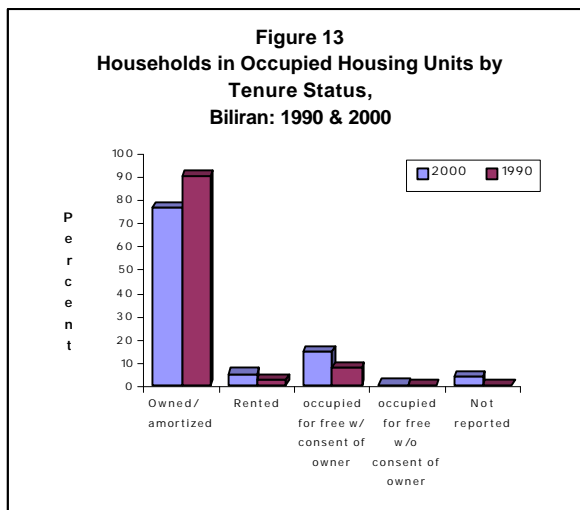
Of the total households, 22.10 percent owned an agricultural land (this included the 3.46 percent of households which acquired the land through Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program (CARP) or were Agrarian Reform Beneficiaries (ARB)); 12.06 percent, other residential land; and 2.04 percent, other land.



Over three out of four households lived in owned/amortized housing units



Over three out of four households (76.08 percent) owned/amortized the housing units they occupied. This figure declined from 89.90 percent in 1990. Other households rented the housing units (4.99 percent), occupied for free with consent of owner (14.62 percent), and occupied for free without consent of owner (0.36 percent).



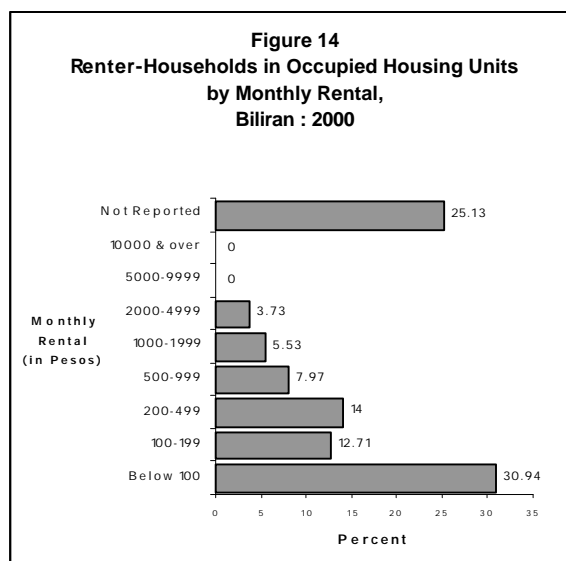
Of the 21,234 households who owned/amortized the housing units, 46.68 percent acquired their housing units through construction by the owner/occupants with or without help of friends or relatives; 32.95 percent, construction by hired/skilled workers; 9.02 percent, through purchase; and 4.61 percent, through inheritance. The remaining 0.54 percent of households acquired the housing units through construction of an organized contractor, and other means (lottery, gift, etc.).

Three in ten renter-households paid at a rate below P100 a month



In 2000, there were 1,393 renter-households in occupied housing units. This figure increased by 849 households from 544 households reported in 1990.

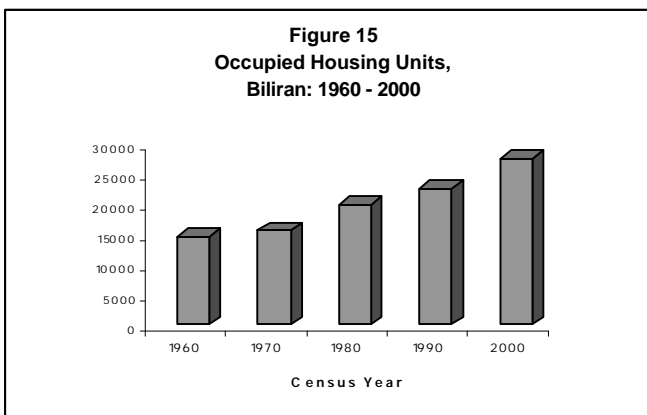
Three out of ten households rented their housing units at a rate below P100 per month, 14.00 percent at P200 to P499, and 12.71 percent at P100 to P199 per month.



HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS

Ratio of households to occupied housing units was recorded at 1.01

A total population of 140,274 or 27,909 households resided in 27,514 housing units. It registered a ratio of 1.01 households to one occupied housing unit and a ratio of 5.09 persons per occupied housing unit, lower than that of the 1990 figure (5.27 persons).



Majority were single-type houses

Almost all (96.65 percent) of the occupied housing units in Biliran were single houses. The remaining 1.86 percent were either duplex (1.23 percent), multi-unit residential (0.41 percent), commercial/industrial/agricultural (0.20 percent), institutional living quarters (0.01 percent), and other housing units (0.01 percent).



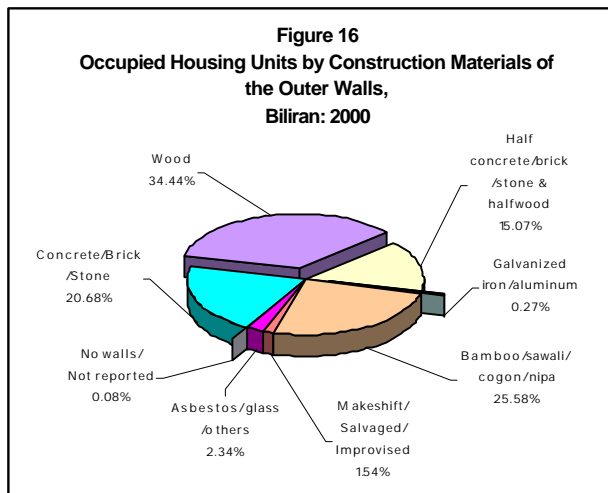
Houses in Biliran had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum and walls made of wood



In 2000, almost half (49.44 percent) of the occupied housing units had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum while housing units with roofs made of cogon/nipa/anahaw constituted 43.65 percent.

These results were in contrast with those in 1990 where majority (72.00 percent) of the housing units had roofs made of cogon/nipa/anahaw while 24.20 percent had galvanized iron/aluminum.

About 34.44 percent of the occupied housing units had outer walls made of wood in 2000. This figure was lower by 10.83 percentage points from the 1990 figure. Housing units with walls made of bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa comprised 25.58 percent; concrete/brick/stone, 20.68 percent; and half concrete/brick/stone & half wood, 15.07 percent.



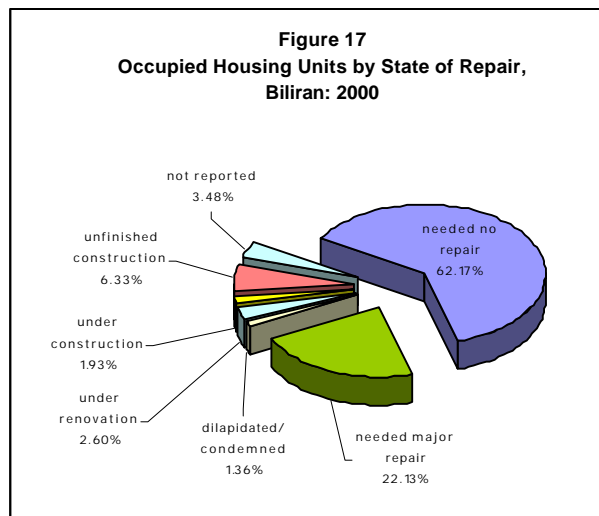
Of the total occupied housing units, 22.65 percent had a combination of cogon/nipa/anahaw for roofs and bamboo/sawali/cogon/nipa for outer walls. Almost one out of five (19.34 percent) had a combination of galvanized iron/aluminum for roofs and concrete/brick/stone for walls.

More than three out of five houses still needed no repair



In 2000, more than three out of five (62.17 percent) occupied housing units needed no repair or needed minor repair only. About 22.13 percent needed major repair, lower by 1.84 percentage points from the 1990 figure.

Occupied housing units with unfinished construction accounted for 6.33 percent (3.91 percent in 1990).

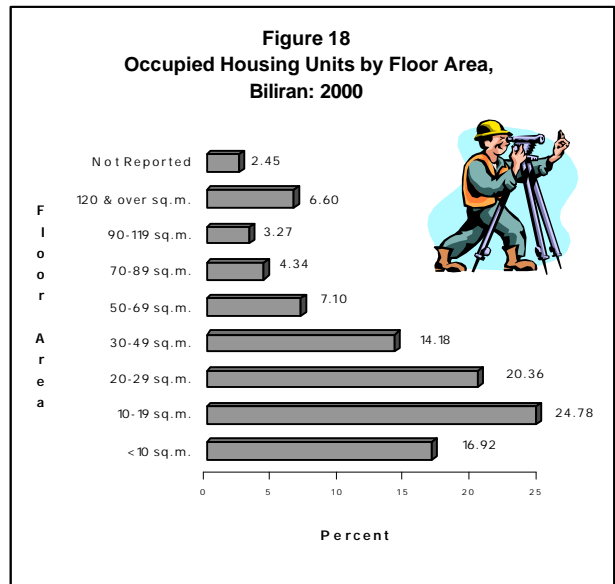


Most of the occupied housing units in Biliran were relatively new with about 31.65 percent built from 1996 to 2000 and 22.39 percent from 1991 to 1995. About 20.87 percent were built from 1981 to 1990.

One in four occupied housing units had 10 to 19 sq.m. floor area

In 2000, the most reported floor area of occupied housing units in Biliran was the 10 to 19 square meter range with 24.78 percent. This was followed by occupied housing units with less than 10 square meters (16.92 percent), 20 to 29 square meters (20.36 percent), and 30 to 49 square meters (14.18 percent).

In 2000, the proportion of occupied housing units with floor area of at least 120 square meters was 6.60 percent, higher than the 1990 figure of 5.38 percent.
