- 1- Basic Literacy refers to the ability of a person to read and write with understanding a simple message in any language or dialect.
- 2- Functional Literacy refers to a significantly higher level of literacy, which includes not only reading and writing skills but also numeracy skills.
- 3- Out of School Youth refers to persons aged 15 to 24 years who are not attending school, have not finished any college or post-secondary course, and are not working.
- 4- Current drinkers are those who consumed one or more drinks of any type of alcohol in the year preceding the survey.
- 5- Binge Drinking or the harmful use of alcohol means excessive drinking of alcoholic beverages in a single occasion, specifically: drinking five or more standard drinks in a row for men, or drinking of four or more standard drinks in a row for women.
