

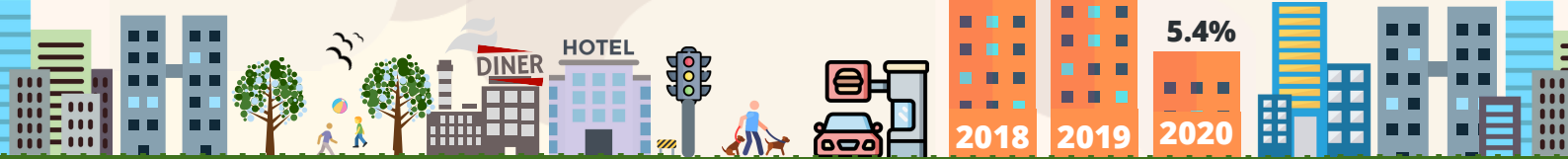


The annual compilation of PTSA provides a comprehensive set of information on tourism that facilitates its analysis in the context of macroeconomic accounts.

TOURISM GROSS FIXED CAPITAL FORMATION

refers to produced fixed assets which are used exclusively or almost exclusively in the production of tourism-characteristic goods and services

TOURISM COLLECTIVE CONSUMPTION

refers to government expenditure associated with support and control of tourism.

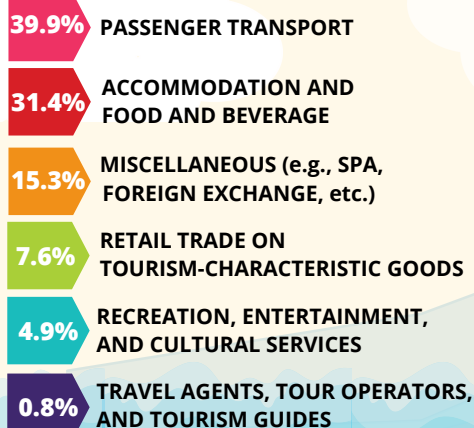
