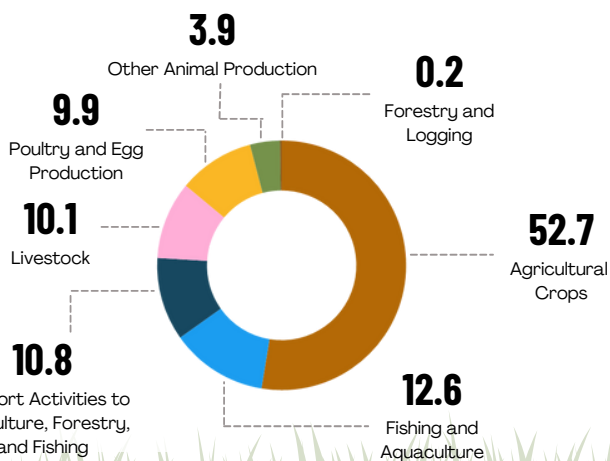

(in percent)

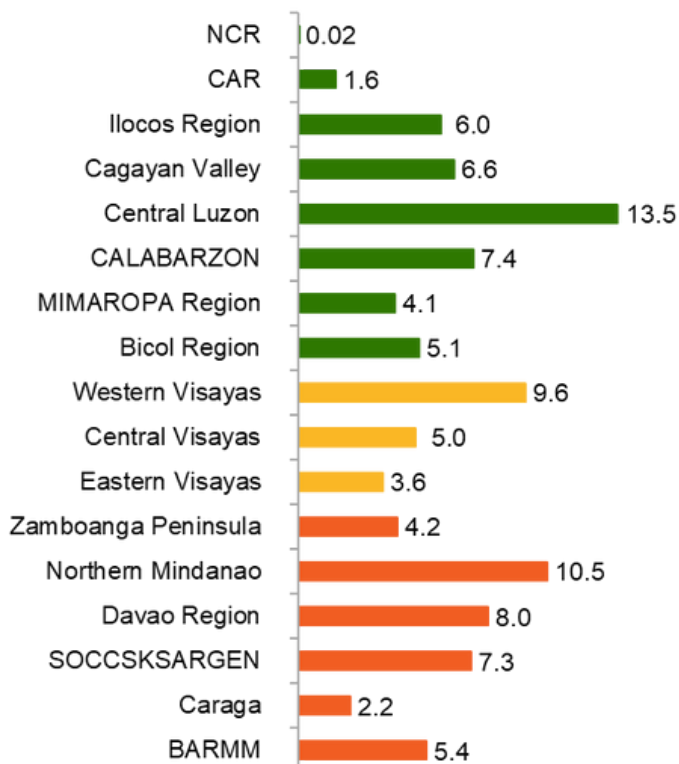
