



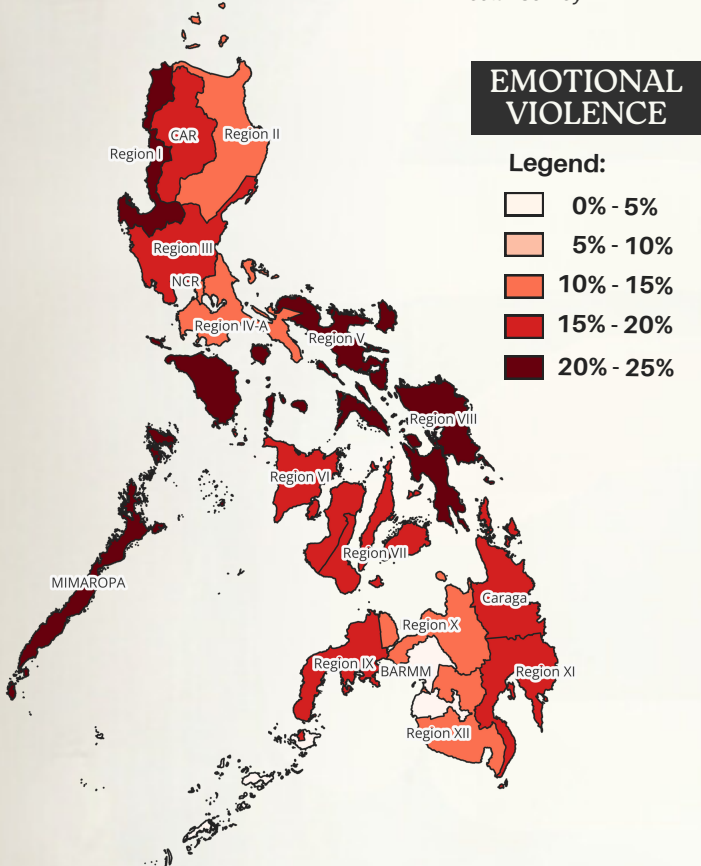

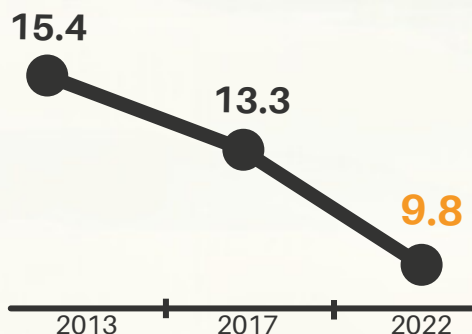
Percentage of women aged 15-49 who have ever had a husband or intimate partner and have ever experienced emotional violence committed by their current or most recent husband/intimate partner

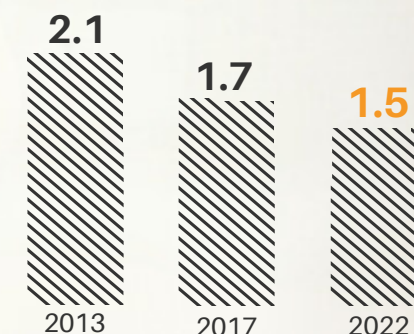


Percentage of Women Aged 15 -49 Who Have Ever Experienced Different Forms of Violence

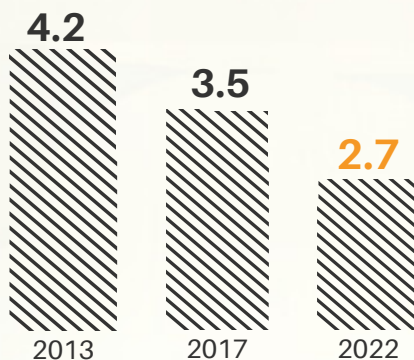

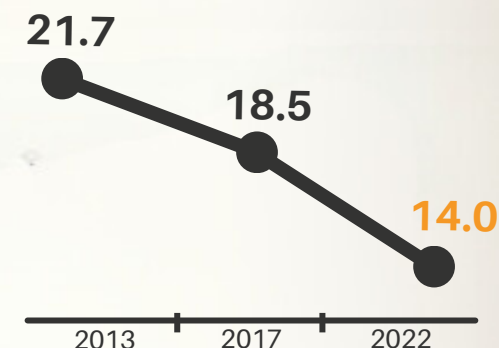
