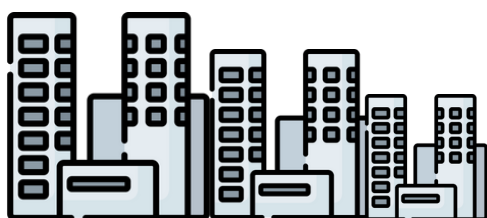
Final Results for All Establishments

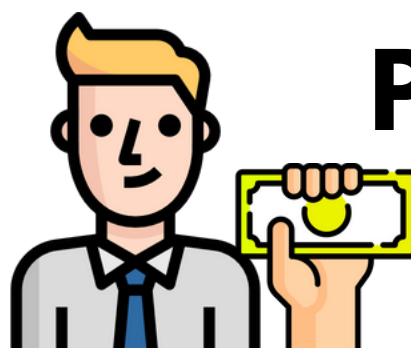

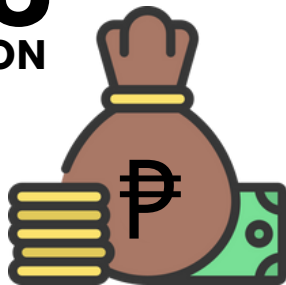
