### Final Results for All Establishments

**ANNUAL SURVEY OF PHILIPPINE BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY (ASPBI)**  
is one of the designated statistical activities of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA). Data collected from the survey provides information on the levels, structure, performance and trends of economic activities of the formal sector in the entire country for the year 2019.

This sector includes **education at any level or for any profession, oral or written as well as by radio and television or other means of communication.** It includes education by the different institutions in the regular school system at its different levels as well as adult education, literacy programmes, etc. Also included are military schools and academies, prison schools etc. at their respective levels. This sector also includes instruction primarily concerned with sport and recreational activities and education support activities. Education can be provided in rooms, radio, television broadcast, Internet, correspondence or at home.

**Note: The results for this sector only covers the private education.**

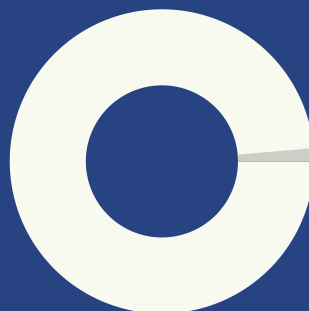
