Non – core ICT industries covered the 18 sectors of the 2009 Philippine Standard Industrial Classification (PSIC). Non – core ICT industries include these sectors, except the Information and Communication sector, and some industries in the Manufacturing, the Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, and the Other service activities sector, which are under the Core ICT Industries.




