Non - core ICT industries include these sectors, except the Information and Communication sector, and some industries in the Manufacturing, the Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, and the Other service activities sector, which are under the Core ICT Industries.

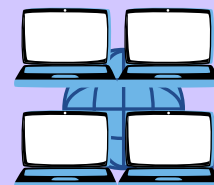

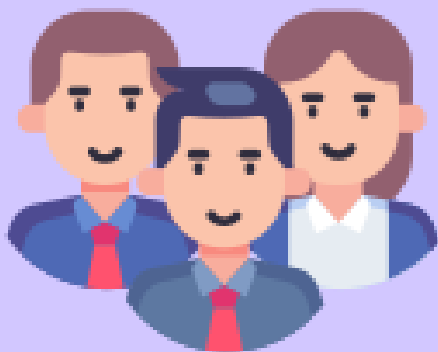
