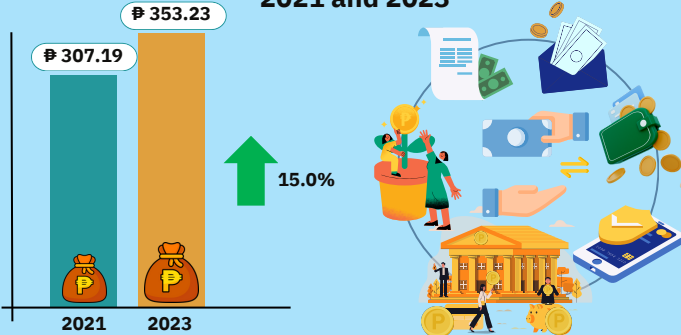
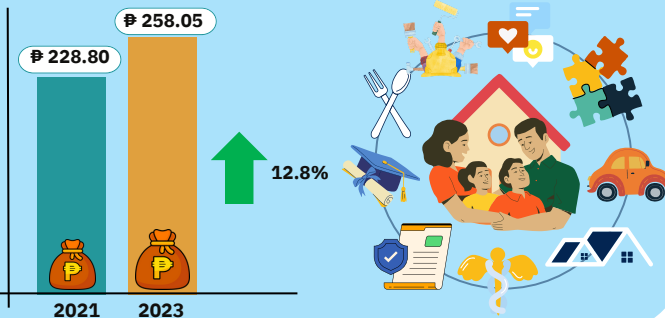


The results of the Family Income and Expenditure Survey provide information on the levels of living and disparities in income of Filipino families, as well as their spending patterns.

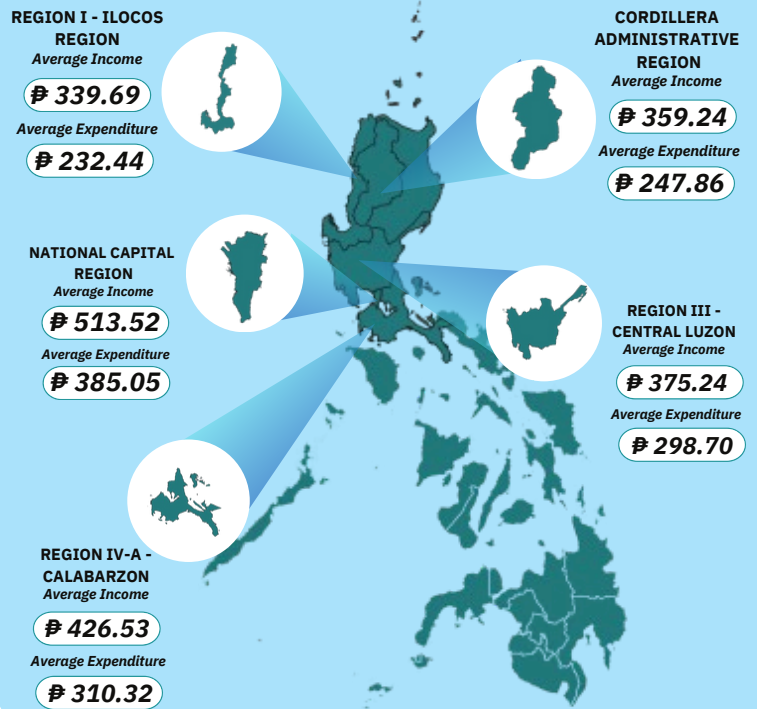
## Average Family Income (in thousands): 2021 and 2023<sup>P</sup>



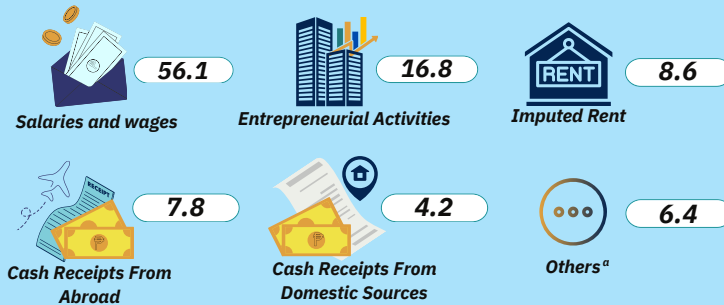
## Average Family Expenditure (in thousands): 2021 and 2023<sup>P</sup>



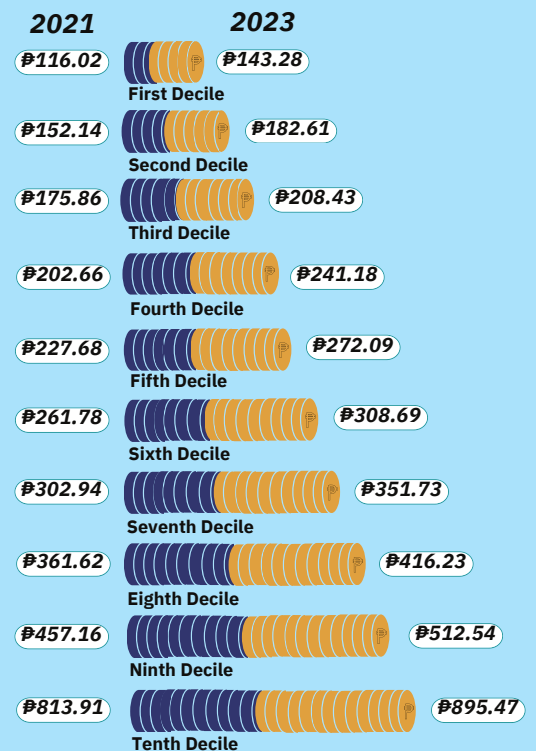
## Top 5 Regions with Highest Average Family Income and Expenditure: 2023<sup>P</sup>



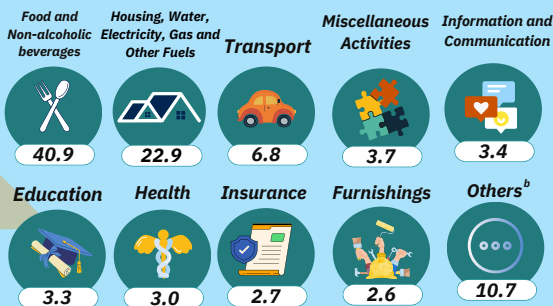
## Percent Share of Sources of Income to Total Family Income: 2023<sup>P</sup>
