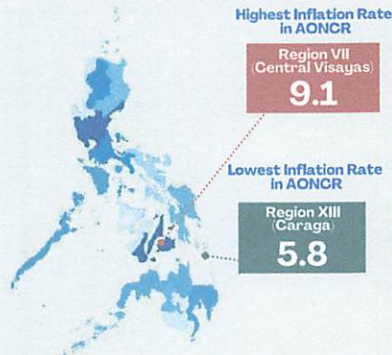
National Capital Region (NCR)



Areas Outside the National Capital Region (AONCR)



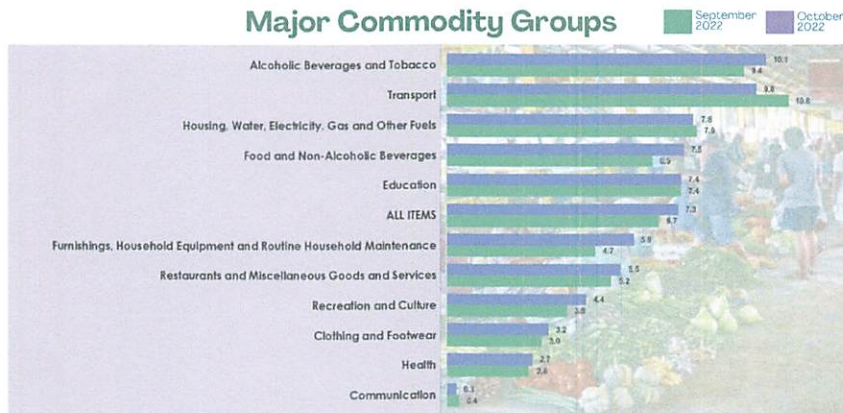
Inflation Rates for Areas Outside NCR

The food and non-alcoholic beverages had the highest expenditure weight of 58.3% of the national total. Restaurants and miscellaneous goods and services had 9.8%, wherein 5.2% is contributed by catering services, the commodity group where the take-away food and food eaten outside the home are classified. This means that the total weight for food in the CPI accounts for 63.5% of the total expenditure, suggesting that for every PHP 100.00 expenditure by the bottom 30% income households in 2012, PHP 63.45 was spent on food. This is the reason why inflation rate for this income group is highly affected by the volatility in the prices of food items.
