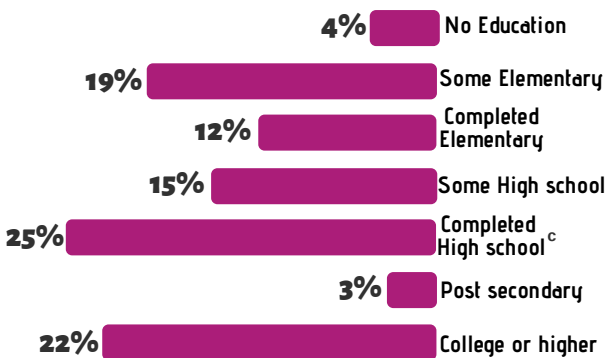

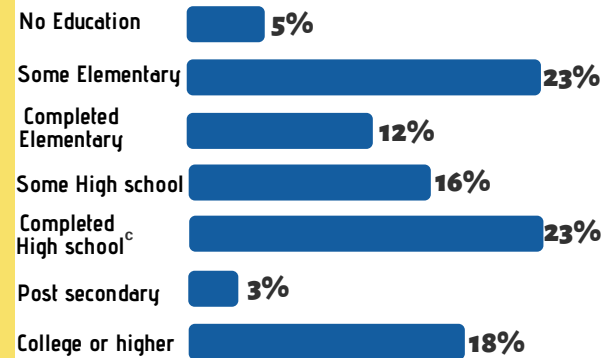

Distribution of the Population 6 years old and over, by Highest Educational Attainment

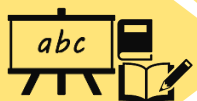

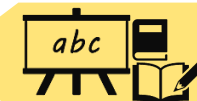
Functional Literacy Rate^e

- a - TVET - is the education or training process where it involves in addition to general education, the study of technologies and related sciences and acquisition of practical skills relating to occupations in various sectors of economic life and social life, comprises formal (organized programs as part of the school system) and non-formal (organized classes outside the school system) approaches." (UNESCO)
- b - Certification - a formal process of recognizing that an individual is qualified in terms of particular knowledge, skills and attitudes based on industry standards. (TESDA)
- c - Completed High School - includes graduate of old curriculum, junior high school and senior high school.
- d - These estimates were based on the final results of January, April and July rounds of the LFS and preliminary results of Preliminary results of October 2018 round.
- e - Functional literacy rate - the percentage of the population 10 - 64 years old, who can read, write and compute or one who can read, write, compute and comprehend.
