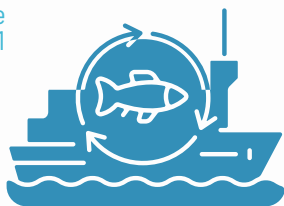

The 2021 total fisheries production exhibited a

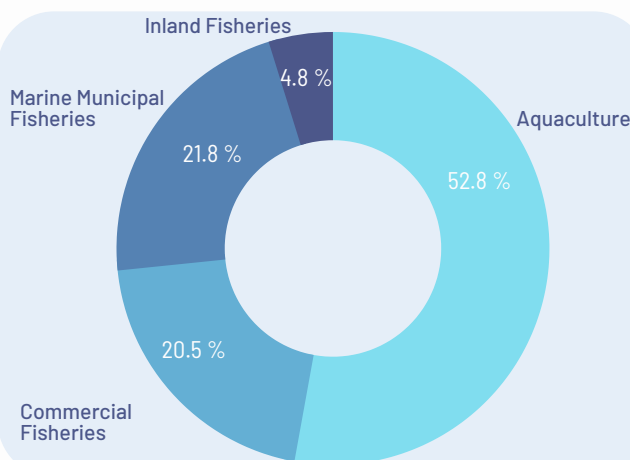
