


2021 POVERTY STATISTICS IN THE PHILIPPINES

BASED ON THE PRELIMINARY 2021 FAMILY INCOME EXPENDITURE SURVEY



Republic Act 8425 of 1997 (Social Reform & Poverty Alleviation Act)

Defines Poor as "Individuals and families whose income fall below the poverty threshold as defined by the NEDA and/or cannot afford in a sustained manner to provide their minimum basic needs of food, health, education, housing and other essential amenities of life." (Section 3 of the RA 8425).

POVERTY THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food and non-food needs, also known as the POVERTY LINE.

AMONG **POPULATION**

A Filipino needed at least PhP 2,406

on average, per month

to meet his/her basic food and non-food needs in 2021.

AMONG **FAMILIES**



In 2021, a Filipino family with five members needed around

PhP 12.030

on average, per month to meet their basic food and non-food needs.

POVERTY INCIDENCE

is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Poverty Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.

> AMONG POPULATION



18.1% of Filipinos were poor in 2021, which translates to

19.99 million poor Filipinos.

AMONG **FAMILIES**



13.2% of Filipino families were poor in 2021, which translates to

3.50 million poor Filipino Families.

FOOD THRESHOLD

is the minimum income required for a family or individual to meet the basic food needs, which satisfy the nutritional requirements for economically necessary and socially desirable physical activities.

AMONG POPULATION In 2021, a Filipino needed PhP1.676

on average per month

to meet his/her basic food needs.

AMONG **FAMILIES** A Filipino family with five members needed around

PhP8.379 on average per month

to meet their basic food needs in 2021

SUBSISTENCE INCIDENCE

is the proportion of families or individuals with per capita income less than the per capita Food Threshold to the total number of families or individuals.

> AMONG **POPULATION**



their basic food needs in 2021 which translates to

6.55 million food poor Filipinos.

AMONG **FAMILIES**



3.9% of Filipino families were not able to meet their basic food needs in 2021 which translates to

1.04 million food poor Filipino Families.
