The prices of eggs are in peso per piece and dairy is in peso per liter and is based on the weighted average prices of carabao, cattle, and goat milk using their volume of production. Farmgate prices is the average of Backyard Livestock and Poultry Survey and Commercial Livestock and Poultry Survey.
