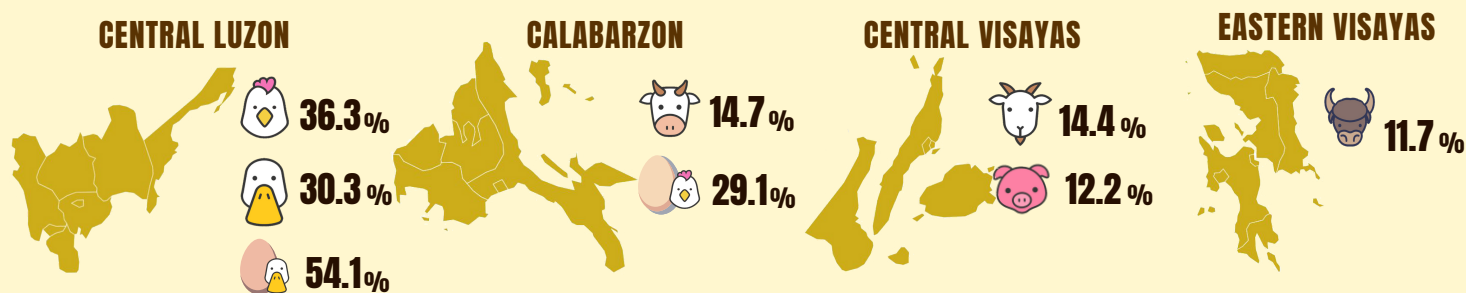

Farmgate prices of chicken are in peso per kilogram, liveweight, while eggs are in peso per piece and were taken from the result of Commercial Livestock and Poultry Survey. Dairy price is in peso per liter and is based on the weighted prices of carabao, cattle, and goat milk.

3/ - Slaughtered/dressed animals are in thousand heads/birds. The unit of measure for livestock is heads, while birds for poultry. The data were sourced from the National Meat Inspection Service and Local Government Units administrative records.
