OVERVIEW OF THE 2017 PSCED

detailed classification of all educational levels in the Philippine educational system

aligned with the Philippine Qualifications Framework (PQF) based on two principal criteria: **1.level of education**, and **2.subject-matter content**of the study

patterned after the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED) and ISCED Fields of Education and Training (ISCED-F) developed by the UNESCO

COMPARABILITY

Promotes comparability of data over time and across space

SUIT LOCAL CONDITION

Patterned after international classifications but with some modifications to suit national/local conditions



FRAMEWORK

Serves as framework for data collection, processing, and compilation to ensure uniformity, consistency and comparability of data produced by both government and private sectors

INTEGRATE HUGE DATA Means for aggregating/

integrating huge data
