It is a mechanism for setting the directions, thrusts, and priorities of the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) which contains statistical development programs (SDPs) and activities for the medium-term. The PSDP serves as a tool for integrating and coordinating the statistical activities in the PSS.

GOALS

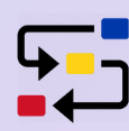
- Accurate, relevant, timely, reliable, and accessible statistics for evidence-based decisions and policies
