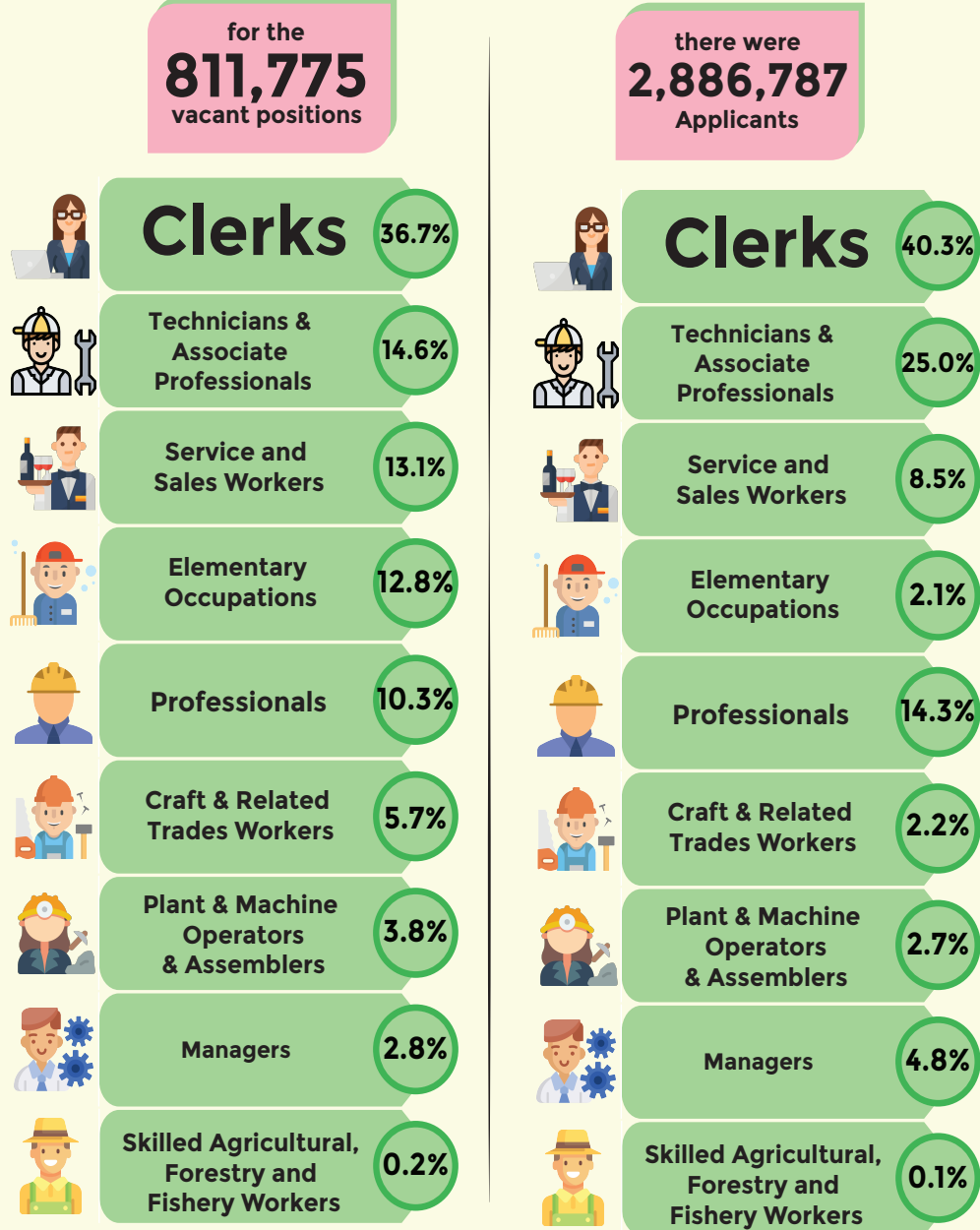

Percent Share to the Number of Vacancies and Applicants by Major Occupation Group



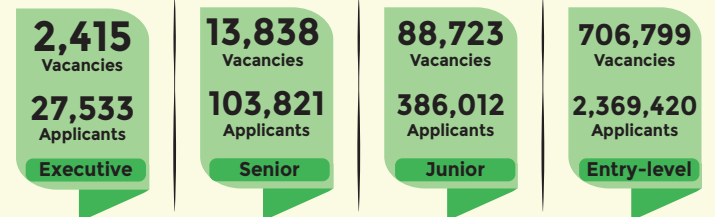
Job Vacancies by Status of Employment



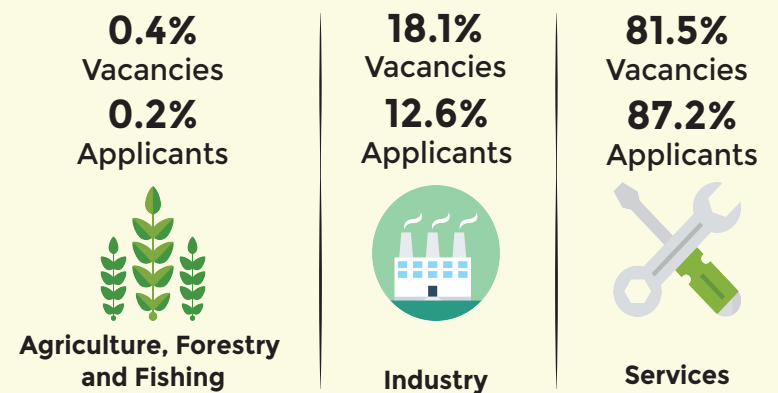

Total Number of Job Vacancies and Applicants by Type of Position



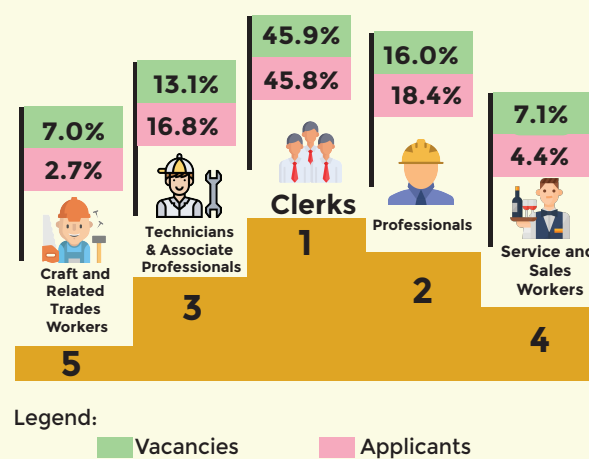
Distribution of Vacancies and Applicants in Establishments with 20 or more Workers by Sector



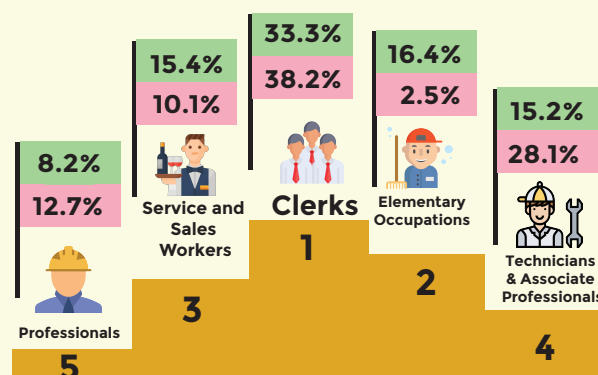
Average Number of Applicants Per Vacant Position by Major Occupation Group



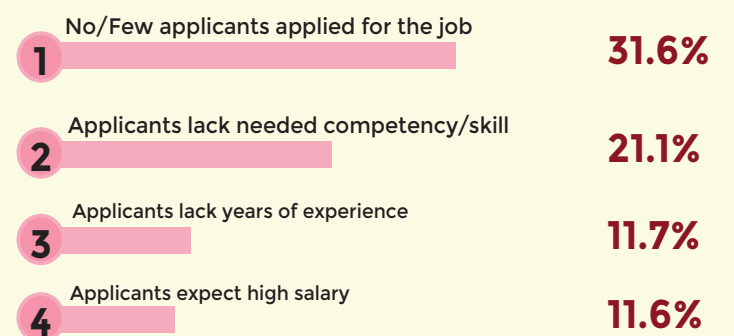
Top 5 Hard-to-Fill Occupations by Number of Vacancies and Applicants



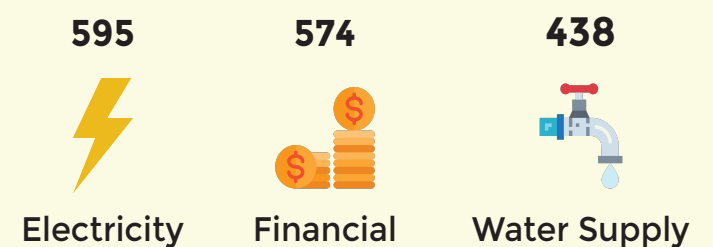
Top 5 Easy-to-Fill Occupations by Number of Vacancies and Applicants
