**PSA Memorandum Order No. 01**

**ESTABLISHING THE  
INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON INFRASTRUCTURE STATISTICS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 10 of Republic Act No. 10625 or the "Philippine Statistical Act of 2013" provides for the establishment of the Interagency Committee on Infrastructure Statistics (IACInfraStat);

**WHEREAS**, the establishment of the IACInfraStat was approved by virtue of PSA Board Resolution No. 04, s. 2014;

**WHEREAS**, the IACInfraStat is an appropriate mechanism for coordination and providing the proper forum for the exchange of views concerning infrastructure statistics;

**WHEREAS**, the IACInfraStat shall serve as a venue for discussion and resolution of issues, review current techniques/methodologies, and recommend policies and workable schemes towards the improvement of infrastructure and other related statistics;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the IACInfraStat is hereby established with the following composition and terms of reference:

1. Department of Information and Communications Technology
2. Department of Public Works and Highways
3. Department of Transportation
4. Metropolitan Manila Development Authority
5. National Economic and Development Authority
6. Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)
7. Public-Private Partnership Center

The above agencies shall identify their permanent and alternate representatives to the IACInfraStat with at least the rank of a Director.

The Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson of the Committee shall be elected among the members. Resource persons may be invited in the meetings of the Committee as the need arises.

The specific functions of the Committee are as follows:

1. Serve as forum for the exchange of views and expertise to resolve technical issues and problems arising from the generation, allocation and utilization of infrastructure statistics;



2. Discuss and identify development programs concerning infrastructure statistics for inclusion in and/or updating the Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP);
3. Identify and coordinate with development partners to support priority statistical programs in accordance with national policies;
4. Recommend an efficient workable scheme in strengthening sustainability of infrastructure statistics; and
5. Perform such other functions as may be deemed necessary/critical for the PSS in general.

To enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of the IACInfraStat, the PSA shall review its composition on an annual basis and recommend its reconstitution, if deemed necessary. Meetings of IACInfraStat shall be conducted where a quorum is constituted. A quorum is constituted when a majority of the members are present in the meeting. The PSA shall provide technical, secretariat, and logistics support to the IACInfraStat. It shall also monitor compliance to policies formulated and report periodically to the PSA Board.

The Committee may establish technical working groups (TWGs) and task forces (TFs), as the need arises, to assist in the exercise of its functions, subject to the approval of the PSA National Statistician. Technical, secretariat, and logistics support to the TWGs/TFs shall be provided by the PSA and the concerned agencies. Other member agencies are enjoined to give the same support whenever deemed necessary by the Committee.

The Committee shall adhere to the PSA Guidelines for Interagency Committees, Technical Committees, Technical Working Groups, and Task Forces in the implementation of its activities and in the preparation of reports and recommendations. It shall submit to the PSA National Statistician its work program and shall report on the progress of its work, including the findings and recommendations on issues referred to it.

This Memorandum Order takes effect on 31 January 2022.
