BACKGROUND

- The Philippine National Government through the Department of Health (DOH) mandates all hospitals to submit hospital statistical report annually.
- Shift from paper-based to electronic submission or reports
- Increased efficiency for data analysis and basis for policy and standards development

Data were extracted from the Online Health Facility Statistical Report System




Online Health Facility Statistical Report System





Usefulness of Hospital Statistical Reports


- 1. Basis for legislation to upgrade service capability and increase bed capacity of DOH hospitals (27 as of June 2019)
