Department of Agriculture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide facilities for the training of census supervisors/enumerators • Provide communication facilities for census operations • Undertake publicity and information drive among its personnel and partner agencies • Provide services of personnel especially from the Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS) and Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) to serve as trainers and supervisors during the field operation
2. Department of Agrarian Reform	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake publicity and information drive among its personnel and partner agencies • Direct the Provincial Agrarian Reform Officers (PARO) and Municipal Agrarian Reform Officer (MARO) to serve as trainers and supervisors during the field operation • Provide land transport facilities in transporting personnel and material and, when necessary, the corresponding personnel complement • Provide communication facilities for census operations
3. Department of Budget and Management	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ensure the immediate release of census appropriations • Realign census funds
4. Department of Environment and Natural Resources	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake publicity and information drive among its personnel and partner agencies • Provide land use and cadastral maps
5. Department of the Interior and Local Government	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Issue directive to Governors and Mayors to convene the Census Coordinating Councils • Issue directive to Barangay Chairmen, Association of Barangay Chairmen (ABC), and other local officials to assist in the census operations • Issue directive to Mayors to direct the Municipal Agricultural Officer, Agricultural Technicians and Aquaculturists to participate actively during the field operations • Provide communication facilities for census operations

8. Department of Public Works and Highways	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide land transport facilities in transporting census personnel and materials and, when necessary, the corresponding personnel complement
9. Office of the President	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop radio/TV plugs • Schedule the recording of TV ad and radio plug with the President • Direct the Bureau of Broadcast and print media by the Philippine Information Agency to assist in the publicity campaign
