Implementing Rules &

- Regulations
 The Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) was approved by the PhilSys Policy and Coordination Council (PSPCC) on 05 October 2018
- The PSPCC is chaired by NEDA Secretary Ernesto M.
 Pernia and co-chaired by PSA Undersecretary Lisa
 Grace S. Bersales
- It was published last 06 October 2018 at the Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation.



Proof of Concept (Agency-to-Agency Agreement with PHLPost)

- The PSA will enter into an Agency-to-Agency (A2A)
 Agreement with the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost) for a **Proof of Concept** (POC)
- The POC will show an effective Registration Process that will capture both the demographic and biometric data of Filipino citizens and resident aliens in preparation for the full-scale implementation of the PhilSys.



Proof of Concept (Agency-to-Agency Agreement with PHLPost)

- PHLPost was tasked to show a POC due to its nine (9) years of experience in doing registration for the members of the Social Security System (SSS) for their Unified Multi-Purpose Identification (UMID) Project.
- Learning from the POC will be considered in the finalization of the Technical Specifications and the Bidding Process for the entire PhilSys (end-to-end solution starting with the Registration Process all the way up to the Card Production)



Partners and Other

For the successing implementation of the PSA is partnering and closely coordinating with other government agencies such as but not limited to the following:

- PHLPost for the A2A Proof of Concept
- DFA for the registration of Overseas Filipino Workers
- GSIS, SSS, Local Civil Registry Offices, PhilHealth,
 HDMF, COMELEC, PHLPost to serve as Registration
 Centers during the roll-out of the PhilSys
- DOJ, BI for the registration of refugees and stateless persons (Persons of Concern) falling under Resident Aliens
- PCOO for the crafting of a Communications Plan for Information Awareness Campaign (IAC) that includes AVPs, Prints and Commercials



Major Timelines

- PSA to hire IT Technical Consultants in coordination with World Bank by November 2018.
- Extensive Information Awareness Campaign (IAC) for PhilSys by November 2018 up to December 2018.
- Conduct of the Proof of Concept (POC) by January 2019.
- Start of PhilSys Procurement by February 2019


