Decoding the **Complicated**

- Age 15 to 30 years (RA 8044)
- “Critical period in a person’s growth and development from the onset of adolescence towards the peak of mature, self-reliant and responsible adulthood” (RA 8044)
- Youth Groups:
 - 15-17 Child Youth
 - 18-24 Core Youth
 - 25-30 Adult Youth
- Youth Sectors:
 - In school Youth
 - Out of School Youth
 - Working Youth
 - Specific Youth Groups

Decoding the **Complicated**

- Youth composes 29.3 per cent of the total population of the country
- 29.59 (29,599,221) million Filipino Youth
 - 15,061,303 are Males
 - 14,537,918 are Females

Decoding the **Complicated**

- The Philippine is still a Population Young People
- Youth Population is steadily growing
- Most are **SINGLE** but evidence their of cohabiting
- One third (33%) of the Employment Sector compose of Filipino Youth
- Many are working in the Service Industries and Elementary occupation
- 20 million registered voters as of 2018
 - 1.6 million (1,638,350) 15-17 years old
 - 18.98 million (18,987,870) 18 to 30 years old

The 2015 National Youth Assessment Study

Decoding the Complicated

- 2,762 youth respondents
- Covering Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao
- Urban and Rural Representation
- 39 barangays were visited
- Sex Distribution
 - 1,242 Male (44.97 %)
 - 1,491 Female (53.98 %)
 - 29 Others (1.05%)

Decoding the **Complicated**

- Gender Distribution:
 - 1,932 Heterosexual (69.97%)
 - 100 Gays (3.62%)
 - 48 Lesbian (1.74%)
 - 71 Bisexual (2.57%)
 - 82 Others (2.97%)
