## Errata on the Final Annual Provincial Labor Market Statistics

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Revisions were made on the Special Release 2022-03 on the Annual Provincial Labor Market Statistics, specifically on the 2020 Key Employment Indicators for Las Piñas, Makati, Muntinlupa, Parañaque, Pasay and Pateros in Tables 1, 2, 3, and 4.
