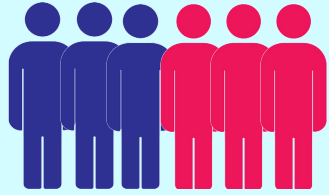

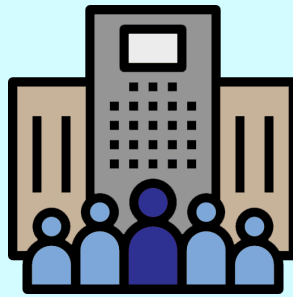

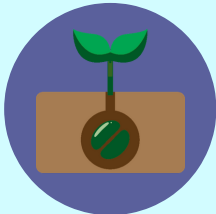
PERCENT DISTRIBUTION OF EMPLOYED PERSONS BY SECTOR

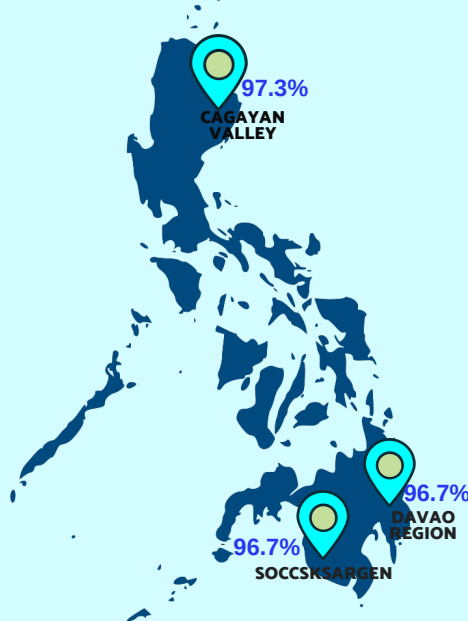
