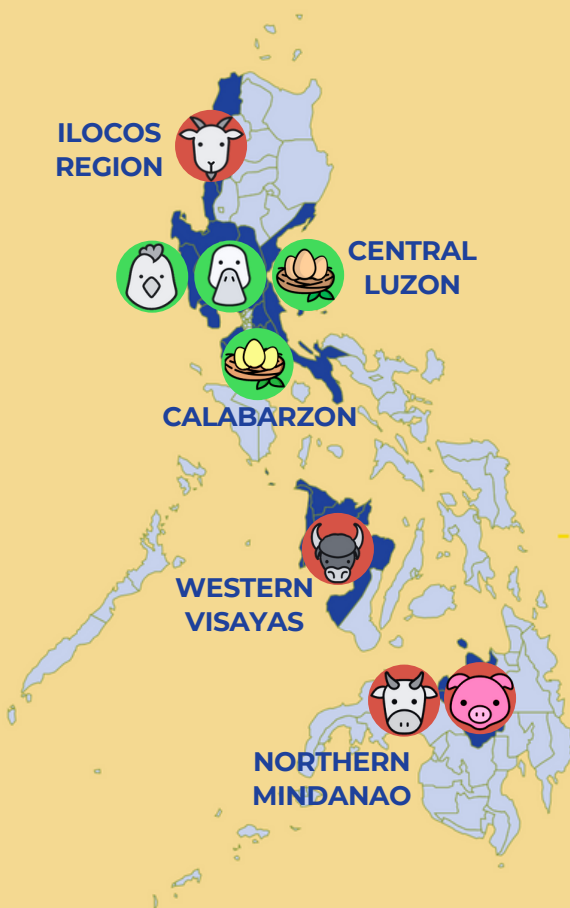

Dairy price is in peso per liter and is based on the weighted prices of cattle, carabao, and goat milk.
