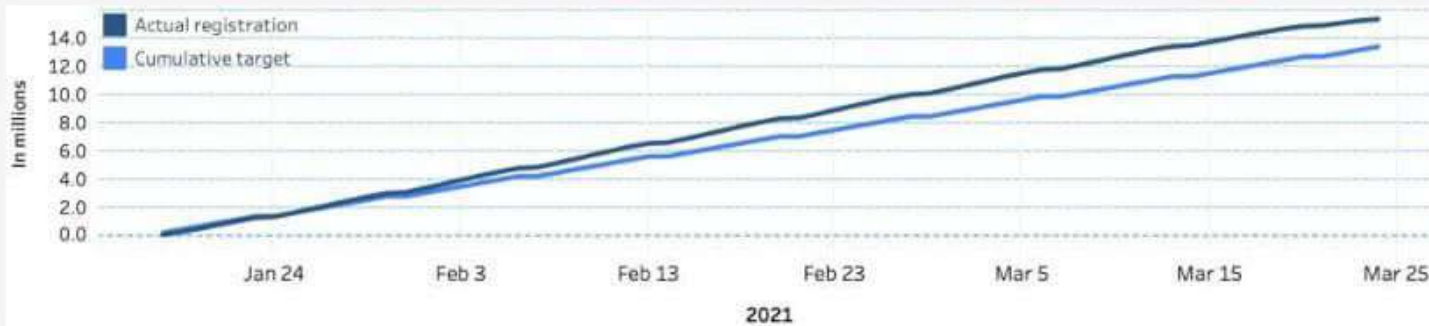

Figure 1: Actual and target step 1 assisted registration



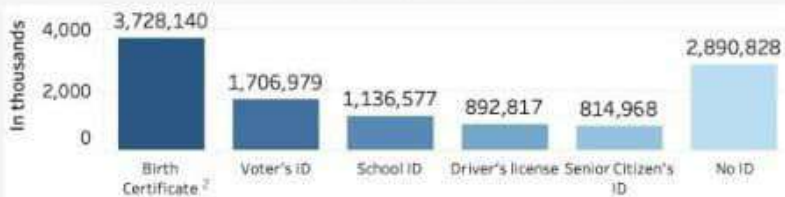
