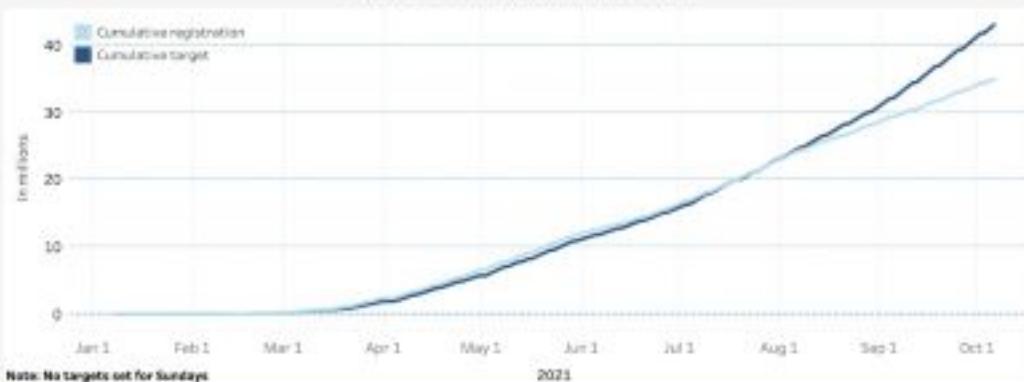

The PhilSys registration is a 2-step process: 1) collection of demographic information, 2) biometric capture and validation, and 3) issuance of PhilSys number (PSN) and PhilID. Step 1 registration is done house-to-house as precaution against COVID-19.

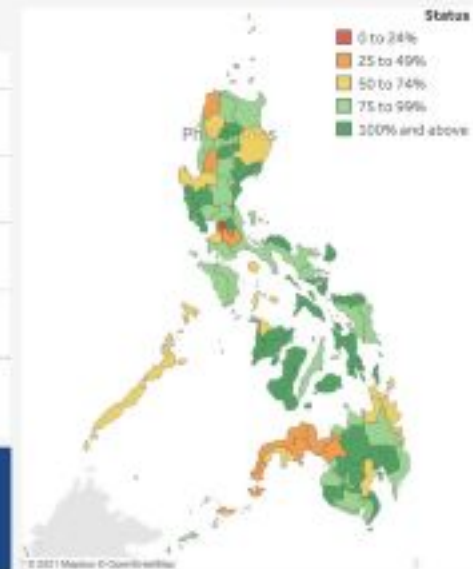
