## Selected Quezon City LGU Staff Participates in the Community-Based Monitoring System Operational Training

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) and the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Quezon City spearheaded the data collection training held on 17 to 20 and 24 to 27 January 2023.

Through this activity, selected LGU personnel were trained on the CBMS common concepts and definitions, as well as the proper administration of CBMS Form 2 or the Household Profile Questionnaire. Moreover, participants were trained on the approaches and strategies which may be implemented during data collection - aligned with the standard protocols and procedures set by the PSA. Aside from theoretical knowledge, a mock interview and field practice was performed by the LGU personnel to immerse them in the CBMS data collection process.

Learnings from this capacity building activity will be passed on to the data collectors in the succeeding level of training.
