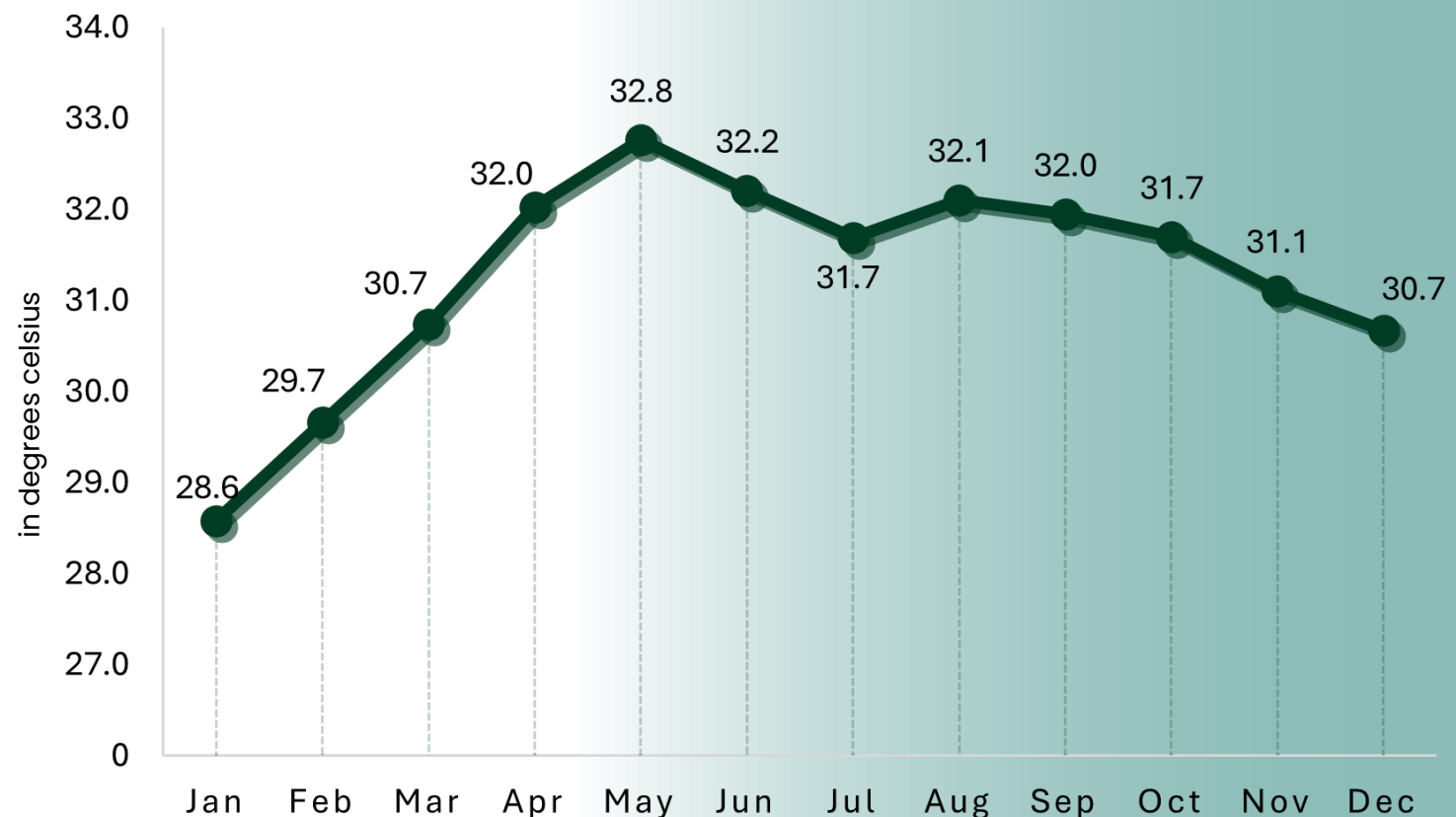

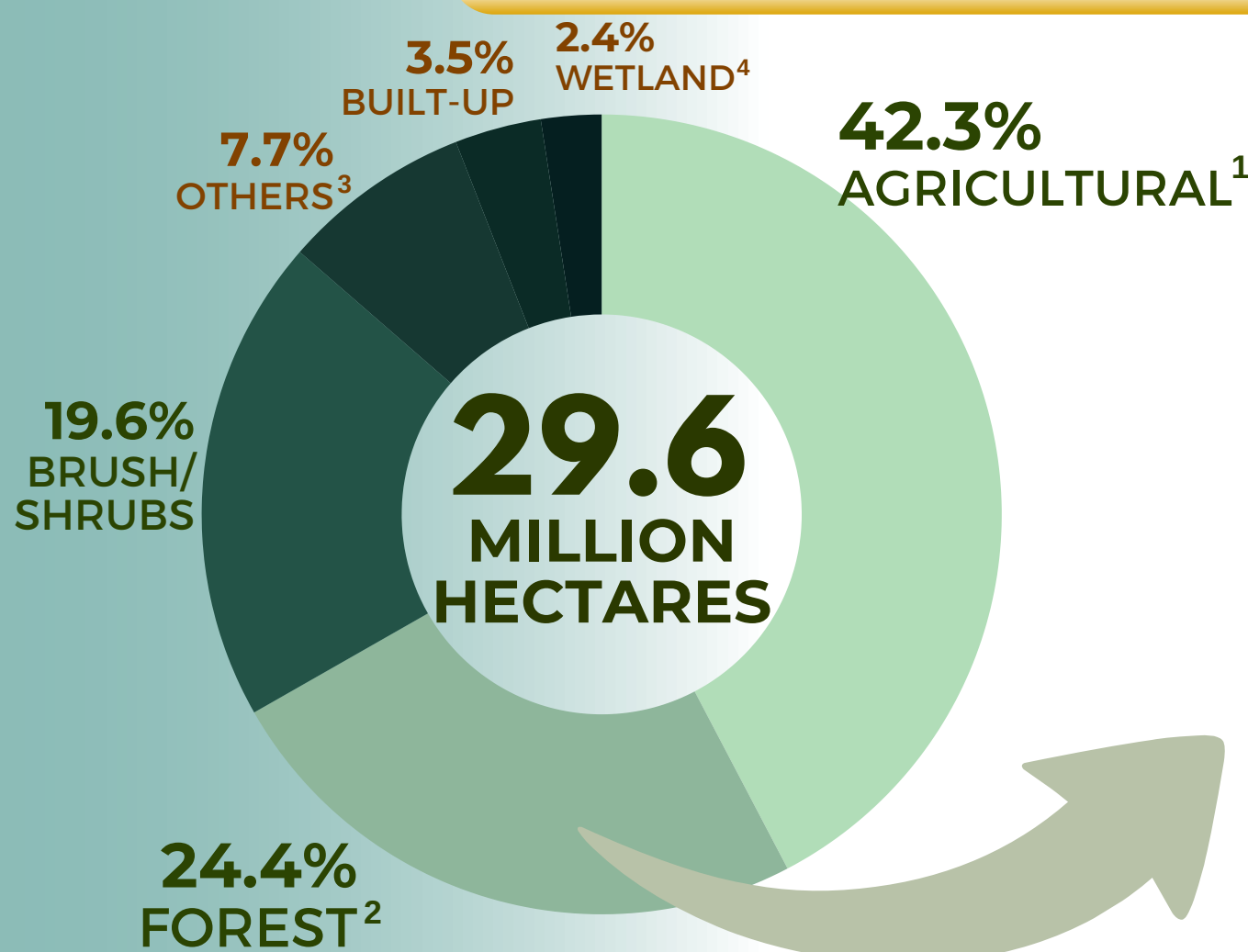
AVERAGE MONTHLY MAXIMUM TEMPERATURE, 2023

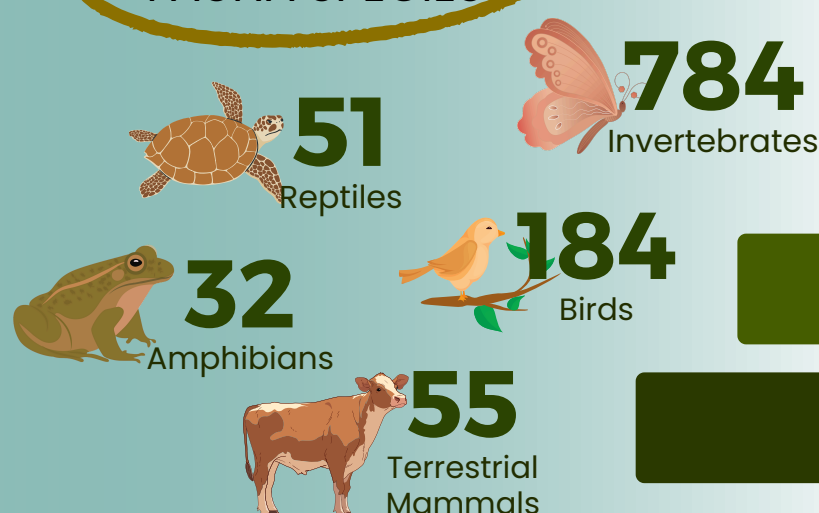
