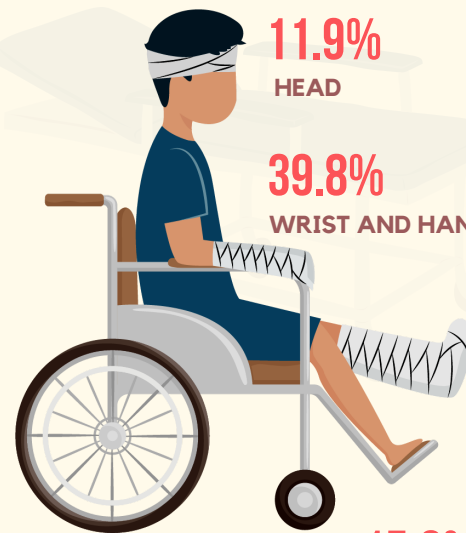

AVERAGE WORKDAYS LOST REFERS TO WORKDAYS LOST OF CASES OF OCCUPATIONAL INJURIES RESULTING TO TEMPORARY INCAPACITY PER CASE OF OCCUPATIONAL INJURY.

COMMUTING ACCIDENTS RESULTS TO DEATH OR PERSONAL INJURY OCCURRING ON THE HABITUAL ROUTE OF A WORKER, IN EITHER DIRECTION, BETWEEN THE PLACE OF WORK OR WORK-RELATED TRAINING AND THE WORKER'S PRINCIPAL OR SECONDARY RESIDENCE, THE PLACE WHERE THE WORKER USUALLY TAKES HIS/HER MEALS OR THE PLACE WHERE HE/SHE USUALLY RECEIVES HIS/HER REMUNERATION.
