FOREWORD

The 2006 Commodity Fact Sheet is the 13th edition of the report published annually by the Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS). The report presents a one-page statistical profile of each of the selected agricultural commodities. It aims to serve as a quick but comprehensive reference on major agricultural commodities produced in the country.

In response to the increasing demand for this report, the BAS continues to expand its commodity coverage. This edition contains the profiles of 47 commodities classified into food and non-food crops, livestock and poultry and fisheries. Each commodity fact sheet contains the following information: number of farms, production, hectarage, yield, prices, exports and import and domestic utilization. Data on the share of the commodity in the gross value of agricultural output is also added in the commodity profile.

The BAS would like to extend its sincere appreciation to the National Statistics Office (NSO) for providing data on the number of farms and foreign trade. Comments and suggestions are highly appreciated.

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

1. Data on the number of farms are taken from the results of the 2002 Census of Agriculture.
2. Volume of production is expressed in metric tons and value in pesos. The values of major commodities at current prices are taken from the Performance of Philippine Agriculture, a quarterly report published by the BAS. For commodities not highlighted in the Performance Report, the values are derived by multiplying the year's volume of production with the average farmgate price in the same year.
3. The share in Gross Value of Output (GVO) is the percent contribution of the commodities highlighted in the Performance Report to the total agricultural output value at constant prices.
4. Major locations are the top producing provinces based on harvested area.
5. Major producers are the top producing provinces based on volume of production.
6. Top yielders are provinces with the biggest production per hectare or per bearing tree.
7. Data on volume of exports and imports are expressed in net metric tons and FOB value, in peso terms. Products for imports and exports are in fresh, prepared or processed forms.
8. Major markets/suppliers are the top exporting/importing countries based on volume. The following are the country specifications:

 - Japan excludes Okinawa
 - Korea, Republic of South
 - Indonesia includes West Irian
 - Iran, Islamic Republic of
 - Malaysia, Federation of Malaya
 - Myanmar, Union of (Burma)

 - Taiwan, Republic of China
9. Data on domestic consumption are represented by net food disposable (NFD) and quantity of commodity that goes to processing. NFD is the amount of food available in its original (unprocessed) form for human consumption. This is usually equated or made equivalent to the quantity consumed.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

10. Values of commodities for food use (NFD) and processing are derived using the average retail and wholesale prices, respectively. Valuation is done only for commodities with available prices. These are commodities which are included in the national market basket.

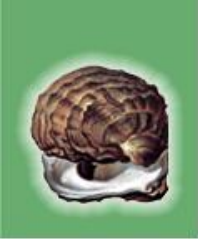
