# **FOREWORD**

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This report is the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of the Commodity Fact Sheets published annually by the Bureau of Agricultural Statistics (BAS). It provides a brief but comprehensive statistical profile of each of the selected agricultural commodities. Information contained are hectarage, production, yield, prices, exports, imports and domestic utilization of the particular commodity.

As in the previous editions, the report covers the food and non-food crops, livestock and poultry. Food crops consist of cereals, commercial crops, fruits and nuts, vegetables and rootcrops. Non-food crops include abaca, tobacco and cutflowers. Livestock and poultry cover hogs, cattle and chicken. This edition comes out with an additional commodity group, the fisheries. It includes milkfish, roundscad, tuna, tilapia, oyster, shrimps and prawns. A total of 38 commodities are incorporated in this report.

The BAS gratefully acknowledges the data provided by the NSO particularly on number of farms for 2002 and foreign trade statistics. Other data were sourced internally.

We welcome comments and suggestions from our clients and stakeholders to further improve this report.

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1. For production, volume is expressed in metric tons and value in pesos. Values are derived by multiplying the year's volume of production with the average farmgate price in the same year.
2. Major locations are the top producing provinces based on area of production.
3. Major producers are the top producing provinces based on volume of production.
4. Products for imports and exports are in fresh, prepared or processed forms.
5. Domestic consumption is the sum of net food disposable (NFD) and quantity made available for consumption. Values of commodities for processing and domestic consumption are derived using the average wholesale and retail prices, respectively.


