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FOREWORD

The PSA releases the First Quarter 2020 to Second Quarter 2023 Seasonally Adjusted National Accounts (SANA) of the Philippines. The SANA presents the economic performance of the country without the influence of predictable seasonal patterns. It is a tool to identify the underlying trends revealing the true behavior of the series, compares quarter-on-quarter changes, and analyzes the seasonal effects in the series. It also provides early signals to the economic planners through quarter-on-quarter changes that will serve as a guide for better plans and decisions in maintaining the economic stability of the country.

This publication includes the Seasonally Adjusted Gross Domestic Product (GDP) compiled at the production side and expenditure side. The GDP production and GDP expenditure and its components are compiled and presented by major industries and by major expenditure items including its details. The Seasonally Adjusted Net Primary Income and Gross National Income are also included.

We welcome comments and suggestions from our data users, clients, and stakeholders for the improvement of this report.

Seasonally Adjusted National Accounts Highlights, Second Quarter 2023

GDP Records a Quarter-on-Quarter Decline of -0.9 Percent in the Second Quarter of 2023

The Philippine Gross Domestic Product (GDP) posted a quarter-on-quarter decline of -0.9 percent in the second quarter of 2023. (Figure 1)

On a seasonally adjusted basis, the main contributors to the second quarter 2023 GDP contraction were: Transportation and storage, -17.9 percent; Manufacturing, -1.2 percent; and Financial and insurance activities, -1.8 percent.

Services posted the fastest decline among the three major industries with -1.02 percent. This was followed by Agriculture, forestry, and fishing (AFF) with -0.97 percent, and Industry with -0.7 percent.

Out of the 16 major industries, Transportation and storage registered the fastest quarter-on-quarter decline of -17.9 percent. This was followed by Other services with -4.8 percent, and Accommodation and food service activities with -2.6 percent.

On the other hand, Information and communication posted a quarter-on-quarter growth of 6.8 percent, followed by Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles with 1.2 percent, and Education with 1.0 percent. (Figure 2)

In AFF, the main contributors to the -0.97 percent quarter-on-quarter contraction were the following: Fishing and aquaculture, -7.5 percent; Livestock, -1.6 percent; and Palay, -0.5 percent.

Among the Industry sectors, the top contributors to the -0.7 quarter-on-quarter contraction in the second quarter of 2023 were the following: Manufacturing, -1.2 percent; Electricity, steam, water and waste management, -0.610 percent; and Mining and quarrying, -0.615 percent. Meanwhile, Construction posted a positive quarter-on-quarter growth of 0.7 percent in the second quarter of 2023.

The top contributors to the decline of the Services sector were: Transportation and storage, -17.9 percent; Financial and insurance activities, -1.8 percent; and Real estate and ownership of dwellings, -2.1 percent. On the other hand, the following industries expanded in the second quarter of 2023: Information and communication, 6.8 percent; Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, 1.2 percent; and Education, 1.0 percent.

On the demand side, Government final consumption expenditure recorded the fastest quarter-on-quarter decline in the second quarter of 2023 with -5.2 percent. The

following expenditure items also recorded contractions: Gross capital formation, -4.4 percent; Imports of goods and services, -2.9 percent; and Household final consumption expenditure (HFCE), -1.0 percent. Meanwhile, Exports of goods and services grew by 1.9 percent in the second quarter of 2023. (Figure 3)

The top contributors to the quarter-on-quarter decrease of HFCE were the following: Clothing and footwear, -23.3 percent; Transport, -2.70 percent; and Restaurants and hotels, -2.72 percent.

Gross fixed capital formation posted a -1.4 percent quarter-on-quarter decline which was attributed to the declines of Durable equipment with -4.7 percent, and Breeding stocks and orchard development with -1.8 percent.

Total imports posted a quarter-on-quarter decline of -2.9 percent, which was attributed to contraction of Imports of goods with -6.3 percent. Meanwhile, Imports of services posted a quarter-on-quarter growth of 10.9 percent.

Total exports expanded by 1.9 percent in the second quarter of 2023. Exports of goods grew quarter-on-quarter by 8.6 percent while Exports of services declined by -5.3 percent in the second quarter of 2023.

On the other hand, Gross National Income posted a quarter-on-quarter growth of 0.9 percent in the second quarter of 2023. (Figure 4)

Net Primary Income also increased quarter-on-guarter by 23.6 percent.

Figure 4. **Gross National Income**, Quarter-on-Quarter Growth Rates, Q1 2020 to Q2 2023, At constant 2018 prices






ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE OF THE PHILIPPINESSEASONALLY ADJUSTED, SECOND QUARTER 2023







Technical Notes

A. Time Series

A time series is a set of observations on a variable measured or recorded chronologically with equal intervals.

B. Seasonality

Seasonality (seasonal component) is a regular fluctuation with similar patterns and magnitude that repeatedly occur within a calendar year and normally observed for high frequency data such as monthly and quarterly series.

C. Seasonal Adjustment

Seasonal adjustment is a statistical technique to remove the effects of seasonal calendar influences operating on a time series.

D. Purpose of Seasonal Adjustment

The purpose of seasonal adjustment is to provide a better understanding of the underlying trends in the series. It removes the seasonal component in the series revealing the true behavior or movement allowing the comparisons between periods. It allows a timely assessment of the current economic conditions and identification of turning points in key macroeconomic variables, such as quarterly gross domestic product (GDP).

E. Methodology

The Philippine Statistics Authority currently uses the internationally recommended seasonal adjustment method which is the X-13ARIMA-SEATS, a seasonal adjustment software program developed and maintained at the U.S. Census Bureau.

The SEATS (Signal Extraction in ARIMA Time Series) seasonal adjustment method available in X-13ARIMA-SEATS uses parameter estimates from autoregressive integrated moving average (ARIMA) models to filter the series and derive the seasonal factors and other components.

The decomposition model for the series may be multiplicative or additive. The multiplicative model assumes dependence between the components therefore monthly seasonal factors for the multiplicative model are ratios with all positive values. Meanwhile, additive decomposition assumes independence of the components, thus seasonal factors may represent positive or negative deviations from the original series. The seasonally adjusted series may exhibit negative values depending on the resulting decomposition of the trend-cycle, seasonal, and irregular component.

In the Seasonally Adjusted National Accounts, the quarterly Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is generated using Indirect Approach or by seasonally adjusting the 80 sub-industries and summing the seasonally adjusted components to produce indirect seasonal adjustment aggregates. Hence, the seasonally adjusted GDP is derived at the production side.

Moreover, the expenditure items are also seasonally adjusted independently and aggregated to major expenditure categories.

The seasonally adjusted Gross National Income is also derived by adding the seasonally adjusted GDP and Net Primary Income.

F. Quality Measures

- Decomposition of the (preadjusted) series should be conducted using either the moving average X-11 method or the model-based SEATS method. The X-13ARIMA-SEATS program, which implements both X-11 and SEATS, is the recommended procedure for seasonal adjustment in the QNA.
- To examine the reliability of the estimates, the Quality Statistic (Q-statistics) is measured for each adjusted series.
