By 2024, at least 99.5 percent of all Filipinos should have their birth registered with the local authorities.


Commitment to the 2015-2024 Civil Registration and Vital Statistics Decade



How will the project be implemented?

CRVS Decade

- Facilitate the birth registration of Indigenous Peoples (IPs), Muslim Filipinos and the poorest sector covering cities/municipalities with low level of birth registration thru mobile registrations and other strategies
- Verify from the PSA Civil Registry System database the existence of birth and issue Omnibus certification of negative results;
- Remove/minimize barriers for registrations. (tedious requirements, fees for delayed registration, etc.);
- Provide Civil Registry forms needed during the registration (c/o PSA);
- Assist the registrants in the processing of out-of-town registrations of births;
- Issue the birth certificate in SECPA free of charge to the recipients of the project.



Number of Verified with Record and Negative Result under PBRAP (as of 04 October 2022)






