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Republic Act No. 11642

Domestic Adoption and Alternative Child Care Act

INTRODUCTIO



- On January 6, 2022, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte has signed **Republic Act 11642**, also known as the Domestic Administrative Adoption and Alternative Child Care Act, and took effect on January 28, 2022.
- The law created the National Authority for Child Care (NACC) which will be a One-Stop Quasi-Judicial Agency. It exercises all power, functions and responsibilities relating to alternative child care including declaring a child legally available for both domestic administrative adoption and inter-country adoption, foster care, kinship care, family-like care or residential care.
- This Act provides for and allows simpler and inexpensive domestic administrative adoption and streamline services for alternative care.





Republic Act No. 11642

Domestic Adoption and Alternative Child

INTRODUCTIO

- It aims to screngthen alternative child care and providing an administrative process of domestic adoption, reorganizing for the purpose of the Inter-country Adoption Board (ICAB) into the NACC.
- Amending for the purpose of:
 - Republic Act No. 8043 or the Inter-Country Adoption Act of 1995;
 - Republic Act No. 11222 or an Act Allowing the Rectification of Simulatec Birth Records and Prescribing Administrative Adoption Proceedings for the Purposes;
 - **Republic Act 10165** or an Act to Strengthen and Propagate Foster Care and to Provide Funds Therefore.
- It also aims to repeal:
 - Republic Act No. 8552 or the Domestic Adoption Act of 1998; and
 - Republic Act No. 9523 or an Act Requiring the Certification of the DSWD to Declare a Child Legally Available for Adoption.







Guidelines in the Registration of the Final Order of Adoption pursuant to Republic Act No. 11642



COVERAG

This Memorandum Circular applies to the registration of final orders of adoption, preparation of the new Certificate of Live Birth (COLB)/Report of Birth (ROB) pursuant thereto, and rescission of adoption rendered by the Executive Director of NACC.



EXCLUSION

This does not cover adoptions and rescissions of adoption decreed by the courts and administrative adoption under the Simulated Birth Rectification Act as there are separate registration guidelines for them. Also, this will not include adoption with double or multiple registration of births.

This guidelines shall not also cover Foreign Court Decrees of Adoption that did not pass through NACC or ICAB.







WHAT TO FILE

The required documents for registration at the LCRO or PFSP are:

- The original/certified photocopy of the Order of
- **1.** Adoption with attached original/certified Draft New COLB/ROB; and
- The original/certified photocopy of the Certificate of Finality of the Order of Adoption.

owever, the adult adoptee, adopting parent/s or his/her authorized presentative may register the Order of Adoption and its Certificate of nality to the Local Civil Registrar.

born abroad, the NACC, the adult adoptee, adopting parent/s or his/her ithorized representative shall cause the registration of the Order of Joption and its Certificate of Finality at the PFSP having jurisdiction of e child through DFA.



WHEN TO

REGISTER
The RACCO, adult adoptee, adopting parent/s or his/her authorized representative shall cause the registration of the order of adoption within 30 days from the issuance of the certificate of finality.

If not made within the prescribed period, the same shall be considered as delayed registration, in which case, the registrant shall execute an affidavit showing the circumstances and reasons why the adoption was not reported for registration within the prescribed period.







WHERE TO



The Order of Adoption and its corresponding Certificate of Finality shall be registered at the LCRO of the city or municipality, or at the PFSP where the child subject of the adoption was born or found.

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Procedures on the Registration of the Order of Adoption and Certificate of Finality



The Executive Director shall provide the original printed copy through courier the Order of Adoption to the concerned parties (PAP/s, RACCO, LCR/s, PFSPs, and PSA)

After the lapse of ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Order of Adoption and no motion for reconsideration or appeal was made, the Executive Director shall issue and provide a Certificate of Finality to the concerned parties (PAP/s, RACCO, LCR/s, PFSPs, and PSA)



Registration Process



It shall be the duty of the RACCO, the adult adoptee, adopting parent/s or his/her authorized representative to cause the registration of the Order of Adoption, with its corresponding Certificate of Finality, to the LCRO of the city or municipality where the child was born or found.

→ If born abroad, the NACC, the adult adoptee, adopting parent/s or his/her authorized representative shall cause the registration of the Order of Adoption and its Certificate of Finality at the PFSP having jurisdiction of the child through DFA.





Registration Process

If it is the Adult Adoptee, Adopter or his/her authorized representative who shall apply for the registration of the Order of Adoption, and its corresponding Certificate of Finality, the concerned civil registrar shall verify the authenticity of the submitted Order of Adoption, or in the case of Inter-Country adoption, the Certification issued by ICAB/NACC that the adoption was processed through Inter-Country Adoption Law, and Certified True Copy of Placement Authority from NACC based or proof the following:



Received original copy of the said Order of Adoption previously endorsed by the Executive Director, if available; or

Certification or letter coming from the concerned RACCO or NACC confirming the authenticity of the Order,
Certification issued by ICAB/NACC that the adoption was processed through Inter-Country Adoption Law and Certified True Copy of Placement Authority from NACC

Registration Process at the LCRO/PFSP

CASE 1: For Children Born in the Philippines

LCR shall not register the Order of Adoption if he/she finds any discrepancies of entries in the Order of Adoption and/or Certificate of Finality

Refer to the NACC for correction and its subsequent issuance of Amended Order of Adoption and/or Amended Certificate of Finality.

The concerned LCR shall verify the authenticity of the submitted Order of Adoption Register the Order of Adoption with the Certificate of Finality, and enter the same to the corresponding Book of Registry for Court Decrees, designating the proper registry number.

Once registered, the concerned LCRO shall issue the Certificates of Registration and Authenticity of the Order of Adoption.

The concerned LCR shall transmit the fourth copy of the new COLB to the Executive Director within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of the Order of Adoption and Certificate of Finality as proof of compliance through registered mail or any courier service.

After sealing the original and annotated
Certified Photocopy of the COLB, the
concerned LCRO shall prepare and issue a
New COLB in 4 copies with the same registry
number as in the original COLB/COF/ COLB
of Person with No Known Parents

Annotation shall be:
"The child is hereby
adopted pursuant to
Order of Adoption
under Case No. ____
dated ____rendered
by Executive
Director ____ of the
NACC in accordance
with RA 11642"

The LCR shall retain the original COLB without annotation and seal the same, including the certified copy of the COLB with annotation reflecting the adoption, in the civil registry records. The CPC shall be stamped "Cancelled" and sealed with annotation







Registration Process at the LCRO/PFSP

CASE 2: For Children Born Outside the Philippines

The Consul General/Consul/
Vice Consul shall not register the
Order of Adoption if he/she finds
any discrepancies of entries in
the Order of Adoption.

Refer to the NACC through the DFA for correction and its subsequent issuance of Amended Order of Adoption and Amended Certificate of Finality.

The concerned Consul
General/Consul/Vice Consul shall
verify the authenticity of the
submitted Order of Adoption

Register the Order of Adoption with the Certificate of Finality, and enter the same to the corresponding Book of Registry for Court Decrees, designating the proper registry number.

The concerned Consul
General/Consul/ Vice
Consul shall transmit the
fourth copy of the new
ROB to the Executive
Director through the DFA
within thirty (30)
calendar days from
receipt of the Order of
Adoption and Certificate
of Finality.

After sealing the original ROB and the certified photocopy with annotation, the concerned PFSP shall prepare and issue a new ROB in 4 copies with the same registry number as in the original ROB.

The Consul
General/Consul/Vice
Consul shall retain the
original ROB without
annotation and seal the
same, including the
certified copy of the ROB
with annotation reflecting
the adoption, in the civil
registry records. <SAME
ANNOTATION IN CASE 1>

Once registered, the concerned CG/Consul/Vice Consul shall issue the Certificates of Registration and Authenticity of the Order o Adoption. PFSP are required to keep a Registry Book of Administrative Adoption





Registration Process at the LCRO/PFSP

CASE 3: For Children Found within the Premises of the Philippine Embassies/Consulates,
Offices and within the Territories abroad in accordance with RA 11767

The Consul General/ Consul/Vice Consul shall not register the Order of Adoption if he/she finds any discrepancies of entries in the Order of Adoption Refer to the NACC through the DFA for correction and its subsequent issuance of Amended Order of Adoption and Amended Certificate of Finality.

Register the Order of Adoption with the Certificate of Finality, and enter the same to the corresponding Book of Registry for Court Decrees, designating the proper registry number.

without annotation and
seal the same, including
the certified copy of the
COLB of Persons with no
Known Parents with
annotation reflecting
the adoption <SAME

After sealing the original COLB of Persons with no Known Parents and the certified photocopy with annotation, the concerned PFSP shall prepare and issue a new COLB in four (4) copies with the same registry number as in the original COLB of Persons with no Known Parents

Registration Process at the LCRO/PFSP

CASE 4: Foreign Court Decree of Adoption that was processed through the ICAB/NACC

The City Civil Registrar of Manila shall register the Foreign Court Decree of Adoption and enter the same in the Registry Book for Court Decrees, designating the proper registry number. Once registered, the CCRO of Manila shall issue the Certificate of Registration of the Foreign Court Decree of Adoption.

After registration, CCRO of Manila or petitioner or his/her authorized representative shall furnish a copy of the following documents to the concerned LCRO or PFSP through DFA where the child was born or found.

- 1) CPC of the Foreign Decree of Adoption;
- 2) CPC of the Certificationb issued by ICAB/NACC that the adoption was processed through Inter-Country Adoption Law;
- 3) CPC of Placement Authority issued by ICAB/NACC; and
- 4) Original copy of the Certificate of Registration issued by CCRO Manil

Preparation of the New Certificate of Live Birth/Report of Birth depending on the birth record prior to adoption by the concerned LCRO/PFSP where the child was born or found.

- For Children born within the Philippines, the concerned LCRO shall follow the procedures in CASE 1;
- For Children born outside the Philippines, the concerned PFSP shall follow the procedures in CASE 2; and
- For Children Found within the premises of the Philippine Embassies/Consulates, Offices and within the Territories abroad in accordance with RA 11767 shall follow the procedures in CASE 3.

Registration of the Order of Rescission of Adoption

Secure and retain a certified photocopy of the New COLB/ROB without annotation

Stamp the word
"CANCELLED" on the original
copy of the New COLB/ROB
(amended)

Annotate the remarks on the New COLB/ROB:

"The COLB/ROB of _____ bearing Reg. No. ____ is hereby cancelled pursuant to Order of Rescission of Adoption dated ____ rendered by Exec Dir. ____ of the NACC under Case No. ___ in accordance with RA 11642. Henceforth, the adoption of the said child is hereby rescinded.

Annotate on the corresponding entry in the Registry Book where the original COLB/COF/ROB/COLB of Persons with No Known Parents was entered

Issue the copy of the original un-annotated COLB/COF/ROB/COLB of Persons with No Known Parents to the proper interested party whenever requested.

Transmit the certified photocopy of the cancelled New COLB/ROB to NACC as proof of compliance.

Unseal the original COLB/COF/
ROB/COLB of Persons with No Known Parents
prior to adoption and certified photocopy of the
COLB/COF/ROB/COLB of Persons with No
Known Parents with previous annotation
reflecting the Order of Adoption




