SUBJECT

<u>Duty to Preserve Copy of Civil Registry Documents Prior to</u>

Annotation/Putting any Remarks or Adoption

It is the practice of most local civil registrars to directly annotate or put any remarks to the civil registry documents on their files without retaining a copy thereof prior to annotation/putting any remarks or adoption. However, the said practice impedes the subsequent processing of corrections/amendment of birth certificate in case of adoption.

Under Memorandum Circular 2012-02 (Guidelines in the Submission of Documents for Court Decision/Order), the National Statistics Office (now Philippine Statistics Authority) shall process the annotated civil registry documents and amended birth certificate in case of adoption upon submission of the following documents:

XXX XXX XXX

6. Original/CTC of the civil registry document without annotation/birth certificate prior to adoption.

In view of the foregoing, all civil registrars are instructed to retain a certified copy of the civil registry documents prior to annotation/putting any remarks or adoption in order to process the affected documents pursuant to the abovementioned memorandum.
