held on 24-28 November 2014 in Bangkok, Thailand



Governments adopted the *Ministerial*Declaration to

"Get Every One in the Picture"

in Asia and the Pacific and committed to focus their efforts on **improving national CRVS systems** 



The Economic and Social Commission for Asia and the Pacific adopted *resolution 71/14* on the Asia and the Pacific Registration and Vital Statistics Decade 2015-2024 in May 2015

Accurate, complete and timely vital statistics (including causes of death) are produced based on registration records and are disseminated








### A. Birth Registration

1. Assessing the level of birth registration (1995-2015) based on Census


