Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647 issued on 20 September 1990, the month of October of every year was declared as the National Statistics Month (NSM) which aims to promote, enhance and instill nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society, and to elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standards of statistics in the country.

In line with this, the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) will celebrate the 33rd NSM this October 2022, wherein the opening ceremony will coincide with the 15th National Convention on Statistics (NCS) slated for October 3-5, 2022. The Steering Committee for the 33rd NSM/15th NCS, which is chaired by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), has been reactivated to oversee and coordinate the implementation of the various activities and programs to be undertaken during the month-long celebration. The DILG is one of the members of the 33rd NSM/15th NCS Steering Committee as well as its Subcommittee on Programs and Awards, and Subcommittee on Advocacy and Promotions.

As part of the 33rd NSM/15th NCS steering committee and its subcommittees, the DILG commits to support this year's NSM/NCS celebration, hence, all DILG central and regional offices and local government units are hereby enjoined to actively participate in promoting the 33rd NSM with the theme: "Boosting the Country's Recovery with Informed Decisions, Better Policies" by holding activities such as, but not limited to, the following:

 Display of the NSM streamer/tarpaulin in conspicuous areas in their respective buildings and/or post it on their websites throughout the month of October carrying this year's theme. Kindly download the

- Conduct other NSM theme related activities.
