### ELIGIBILITY

- The competition is open to all students of Philippine Higher Education Institutions.

### GUIDELINES

- Posted in social media / blogs
- Composed of approximately 200-300 words.
- Should inspire readers in promoting Philippine tourism.

### COMPETITION AND JUDGING

- The competition has two stages: Regional and National.
- First Placers from the Regional Level of the competition will compete in the National Level.
- The Criteria for judging is as follows:

<b>Content and Organization (50%)</b>				
Does the author have a clear point to make?				
Does the content always pertain to the topic?				
Are the ideas organized in a logical way?				
Are the ideas clear and logical?				
Are the introduction and conclusion used efficiently and effectively?				
<b>Language and Style (50%)</b>				
Does the author used appropriate vocabulary?				
Is the vocabulary choice correct and appropriate for the genre?				
Is the grammar correct and appropriate?				
Are spelling, punctuations, capitalizations correct?				
<b>AVERAGE</b>

- Entries must be submitted to the CHED Regional Office on or before the deadline set by the concerned office. Participants may submit the poster personally, electronically (INSERT EMAIL ADDRESS HERE) or through a courier.
