CELEBRATION OF THE

NATIONAL

STATISTICS MONTH (NSM)

Pursuant to NSCB Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 01-13 dated 23 May 2013, enjoining the participation, coordination and cooperation of various sectors in the observance of NSM, and Presidential Proclamation No. 647 dated September 20, 1990, the National Statistics Month (NSM) shall be celebrated every October with two-fold objectives: a.) to promote, enhance and instill nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of the society; and (b) to elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standard of statistics in the country.

The overall theme of the celebration is, "Statistics that Matter to Every Filipino" with Filipino translation "Estadistika na may Halaga sa Bawat Filipino" highlighting the vital roles that data and statistics play in the everyday lives of Filipinos. This 24th NSM Celebration coincides the conduct of the 12th National Convention on Statistics (NCS).

In this regard, all Local Chief Executives are hereby enjoined to actively participate in this celebration by holding activities in the form of symposia, workshops, orientation seminars, exhibits, slide shows and publication of statistical reports, orientations and other relevant information, among others, with particular emphasis indicators and other relevant information, among others, with particular emphasis on the theme. Hanging of streamers during the NSM celebration is also encouraged. The theme may be translated into other major Philippine dialects depending on the focus and direction of its statistical activities, an agency or region may choose to have its own sub-theme.



You may coordinate with the Regional Statistical Coordinating Council (RSCCs) regarding your planned activities using the attached NSCB-NSM Form 1.
